All students accepted into the program will be required to fill out a Medical Emergency Form and sign an "Attendee's Contract" which lists accepted and non-accepted behaviors. Forms should be returned to the Center by July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2012.

### **CANCELLATIONS**

If an accepted applicant can not attend the program and must cancel, s/he MUST notify EWBC by July 13<sup>th</sup> to receive the full deposit back. Applicants who cancel after this date will not receive their deposit back, unless approved by the EWBC manager.
