How to Register

Registration is limited to 20 adults each testing period. Space permitting, you must register at least three (3) working days prior to the test date.

Registration Days/Hours:

Mon. - Wed. : 8:30am-11:30am Thurs. - Fri. : 12:30pm-3:30pm If you cannot come in at these times, call Nancy Rice to schedule a time (714-796-8738).

To register you must appear in person and bring the following:

- * \$125 money order payable to the Orange County Department of Education ONLY for the complete test. <u>There are no refunds.</u> <u>Cash and personal checks are not accepted.</u>
- * \$25 money order for each retest.
- * Acceptable ID (under the "FACTS" column). Also on registration form.

Eligibility

To take the test you must be:

- 18 years old or older, or within 60 days of your 18th birthday.
- 17 years old, has been absent at least 60 consecutive school days, and provides a letter of request from either the military, postsecondary educational institution or a prospective employer (requires approval from Nancy).
- You must also be a California resident (if you are not a CA resident, contact Nancy Rice).

FACTS

What is the cost for the test? \$125 money order for the complete test, \$25 money order for each re-test.

What is acceptable identification?

Bring to the test one of the following:

- CA driver's license or ID card from DMV
- Military ID card
- Passport with CA residency
- Other: Refer to Registration form

How will I know if I passed the test?

- Examinees who pass should receive the High school Equivalency Certificate within 4 to 6 weeks of completing the test.

- Check scores online with your GED® pin*: https://gedcalifornia.ets.org/

*You are the only one who will have this number!

To pass the GED® test you must:

- Receive a standard score of at least <u>410</u> on <u>each</u> of the five subtests <u>- AND -</u> -Earn an average standard score of 450 or higher.
