Scholarship Information:

The award will be a scholarship(s) to Delta College student(s) continuing their education at four-year universities within the state of Michigan. The award will be used for tuition, books and fees.

Criteria:

- > Preference will be given to students who have graduated from Delta with an Associate's Degree.
- The student must have attended Delta College and earned at least 58 credits, or graduated from Delta, and be transferring to a university or college in the State of Michigan. Note: Student must have graduated from Delta, or earned 58 credits from Delta, between December 2013 and August 2014 (this is prior to transferring to a 4 year college or university).
- Student(s) applying must have a 3.0 or higher GPA. In some circumstances, students who have lower than a 3.0 GPA may be given consideration. The recipient should call Delta's Foundation Office at 989-686-9226 with their intentions and have evidence of eligibility relating to academic achievement.
- Recipients must maintain full-time enrollment at (<u>four year university</u>) during their scholarship year. Fulltime enrollment is defined as 12 credit hours per semester.
- Scholarships will be awarded to students who may or may not have financial need.
