THE SWP PACKAGE

Background: Well over a decade has passed since IBPP researchers Crowther, Hann and McMaster (2000), coined the term 'schoolwide pedagogy' to describe highly specialised context-specific schoolwide pedagogical approaches found present in successful Australian schools. Over the intervening years the construct has been developed and refined through research and consultancy by members of the Leadership Research International (LRI) based at the University of Southern Queensland and SWP has become widely accepted as a key element of successful school improvement.

The SWP Package: The key to a successful SWP lies in the process utilised to develop it at the school level. The latest knowledge from the LRI on Schoolwide Pedagogy development is now offered as a Package comprised of a 2-day leadership development experience for school teams accompanied by two (2) follow up teleconferences. Major objectives include:

- To clarify the concept of Schoolwide Pedagogy and its relationship with school improvement.
- To experience a process of developing a Schoolwide Pedagogy.
- To enhance teachers' professional knowledge and skills for leading the construction of a Schoolwide Pedagogy.
- To heighten appreciation of personal pedagogy and how to work with the diverse pedagogies that exist in a school.
- To introduce suitable activities for engaging teachers in exploration and articulation of successful pedagogy.

WHO IS IT FOR?

THE SWP PACKAGE is designed for school teams designated with the task of leading the development of a Schoolwide Pedagogical Framework, namely a Schoolwide Pedagogy.

Arguably the most important feature of a Schoolwide Pedagogy is its construction by the professional community of the school based on distinctive student needs, school values, community features, aspirations for the future, and teachers' most successful practices; a process that requires thoughtful and shared leadership and inventive facilitation.

Hence, the professional experience offered to school teams as part of the SWP PACKAGE focuses on school-based leadership and facilitation of SWP development with a view to schools achieving sustainable pedagogical improvements. Implementing such a process provides a great opportunity to broaden leadership capability within the school and specifically foster teacher-leadership.

Attendance at the 2-DAY PD program

Schools may choose to send 2 (minimum) - 6 persons. It should be noted that outcomes are maximised when school teams in attendance comprise at least:

- the principal or another member of administration
- a middle manager of school pedagogy
- classroom teacher/s.

Teleconferences

Two (2) teleconferences between school and an LRI consultant are available during a 12-month period following the PD experience. Schools will make contact with the LRI administrator to negotiate the timing of these.
