Thank you for selecting **The Ohio State University Football Camps**. We are confident that you will both enjoy and benefit from the instruction you will receive at our camps! Included in this packet is all of the important information you will need to prepare for camp. Please review this information carefully.

Included at the end of this packet is a Parent Consent, Waiver and Release Form.

IF YOU HAVE NOT YET COMPLETED AND RETURNED THE PARENT CONSENT FORM, ANOTHER COPY IS INCLUDED IN THIS PACKET.

THIS FORM IS REQUIRED IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CAMP. CAMPERS WHO HAVE NOT SUBMITTED THE PARENT CONSENT FORM WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE UNTIL WE HAVE RECEIVED IT.

<u>Check-in and Schedule</u>: Check-in for all campers will be held at 9:00am at the Woody Hayes Athletic Center (June 10th or June 23rd). Any outstanding balances due or consent forms will be collected at this time. *Any outstanding balances which are not paid by the first day of camp must be paid at check-in, even if your check has been mailed but not yet received by the Camps Office. Campers will not be permitted to participate in the camp if their accounts are not paid in full upon arrival.*

Campers will be dismissed from the Woody Hayes Athletic Center at 4:00pm.

<u>Parent Consent, Waiver and Release Form</u>: Campers may only participate in a camp's activities after they have submitted a Parent Consent, Waiver and Release Form ("Consent Form"). Football campers should mail their consent forms to the Camps Office:

The Consent Form should be fully completed and signed by the camper's parent or guardian. The parent or guardian should disclose the camper's pertinent medical history, including but not limited to, any medications which the camper is currently taking or required to take. Please note that when you disclose pertinent medical history, you may be requested to provide additional information (e.g., documentation from the camper's treating physician) for our camp medical staff to review prior the camper being permitted to participate in camp. If you have questions, please contact Cara Singel (Assistant Director - Buckeye Sports Camps Office) by email at singel.2@osu.edu. In order to adequately assess your information, please contact us at least 21 days prior to the start of the camp.

<u>Gatorade</u>: The Gatorade G Series, including Gatorade Prime 01, Gatorade Perform 02 (original Gatorade) and Gatorade Recover 03 will also be provided at our instructional sessions. Please note that Gatorade Recover 03 contains whey protein and is not recommended for campers with milk allergies. For more information about the Gatorade G Series, please visit www.gatorade.com.

What to bring:

- Workout shorts and t-shirts
- Supporters
- Sunscreen
- Grass cleats, turf cleats and/or tennis shoes. (It is not necessary to purchase turf cleats just for football camp. Tennis shoes or rubber-soled shoes will be sufficient for the artificial turf surfaces.)
- Quarterbacks must bring a football with the camper's name or school name on the ball.

Meals: Lunch will be provided, along with water and Gatorade throughout the day.

<u>Medications</u>: Medications are generally not permitted at camp. Campers may only carry medications to camp if such medications are intended to treat a potentially <u>life-threatening</u> condition.

<u>With prior written approval from the Camps Office</u>, a camper may carry an EPI-pen and/or an inhaler for asthma. In order to bring an EPI-pen, asthma inhaler, or any other medication to camp, a parent or guardian must make a written request for approval to the Camps Office.

An EPI-Pen, asthma inhaler and any other approved medications must be in the original prescription container with the child's name clearly marked. Children are required to self administer medications whenever possible. Camp staff members, however, are able to administer these medications in an emergency.

To make a written request to bring medication to camp, please contact Cara Singel (Assistant Director - Buckeye Sports Camps Office) by email at singel.2@osu.edu. In order to adequately assess your request, please contact us at least 21 days prior to the start of the camp.

<u>Accommodations</u>: If you have questions about accessibility, have special dietary needs, or need to request assistance to participate in any of the Ohio State Athletics Department's sports camps, please contact Cara Singel (Assistant Director, Buckeye Sports Camps Office) by email at singel.2@osu.edu. In order to adequately assess your request, please contact us at least 21 days prior to the start of the event.

Parking:

General campus parking The use of University parking lots requires a permit at all times. Unless instructed otherwise, you should plan to purchase a temporary parking permit when you park on campus, including when using the parking lots near our camp athletic fields. When parking, please make sure your vehicle is in a legal, marked space.

Please note that certain lots in the North Campus dorm area are privately-owned. These lots are aggressively monitored by tow truck services. If you park in one of these private lots, you car will likely be towed.

Hourly and short-term permits also may be purchased using the self-service Pay-n-Display machines located in these lots. Please note that these machines only accept coins or credit cards (no paper bills). When you purchase a temporary permit from a Pay-n-Display machine you may park in "A", "B", or "C" parking space (see signs in the lot) in the parking lot where the Pay-N-Display pay machine is located.

Parking for football camp Parking for camp is located on the west side of the Woody Hayes Athletic Complex between the Jesse Owens Memorial Stadium and the Bill Davis Baseball Stadium (see enclosed map). Campers and their parents should park in the designated lots for check-in, drop-off and pick-up.

All campers who will have a vehicle on campus for the duration of the camp are required to obtain a parking pass at check-in. Parents and guests observing camp will need to purchase a parking pass for the day(s) they attend. Parking passes will be available at a rate of \$5 per day during check-in or in the football office after

check-in. Passes may also be obtained at the Pay-and-Display machines located in the parking lots. Passes must be visible from the dash or rearview mirror, and cars **must** be parked in designated area(s). Any vehicles that are not parked in an area designated for football campers will be subject to parking tickets. Parking fines are the responsibility of the vehicle owner.

<u>Refunds</u>: The Senior Advanced Camps are non-refundable, regardless of the reason for the cancellation or **no-show**. All session changes must be received in writing (<u>singel.2@osu.edu</u>) by June 1st.

<u>Travel</u>: For those campers traveling via airplane or bus, we will have staff members available to pick you up at either Port Columbus or Greyhound bus terminal. Call the Football Office at 614-292-2531 after June 1st to make these arrangements. Transportation will also be available to the airport or bus station for the return home.

<u>Filming at camp</u>: Parents, guardians, campers and other spectators are <u>not permitted to film</u> any camp activities.

Parents, guardians and other spectators may take photographs during camp provided that: (1) they remain in the public spectator areas; (2) the photography does not interfere with camp activities; (3) they cease taking pictures if requested by a member of the camp staff; and (4) photographs of campers are only taken with their consent.

Campers may take pictures of camp staff and other campers (with their consent) at the conclusion of a camp. The inappropriate use of cell phones, cameras, imaging and other digital devices is prohibited in showers, restrooms, changing room or other areas where privacy is expected by participants.

RULES AND EXPECTATIONS FOR DAY CAMPERS

The safety of our campers is our primary concern. Campers' adherence to these rules and expectations is critical to making our camps safe, rewarding and fun for all participants.

Expectations for camper behavior:

- Follow all instructions of camp staff and immediately consult the head coach or camp director if you are uncertain about these instructions.
- Label all personal belongings, especially equipment.
 Buckeye Sports Camps is not responsible for campers' lost or stolen items.
- Notify a camp counselor as soon as any problem arises, big or small.

Behaviors not permitted:

- Using profanity or inappropriate language, whether it is written or verbal.
- Leaving the camp area as designated by the camp director.
 The Ohio State University is a large campus in a major metropolitan area, so campers are not permitted to walk freely around the campus or surrounding areas.
- Inappropriate use of a cell phone or cell phone camera during camp – phone may be confiscated for the duration of camp.
- Damaging or stealing University or other people's property.
 Camp fees do not cover payment for any lost or stolen items.

While unacceptable conduct is not anticipated from campers, violation of any camp rule or expectation could result in disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal from camp. Refunds will not be issued to campers dismissed from camp for disciplinary reasons.

We expect that parents or guardians of campers will be available (by phone) during the duration of the camp in the event the camp director or other camp staff needs to speak with them about a camper's behavior.

Campers and parents should review this important information prior to arriving at camp.














DRIVING DIRECTIONS FOOTBALL CAMP PICK-UP & DROP-OFF PARKING

We strongly recommend that you use the following directions when arriving for camp check-in, pick-up and drop-off.

From the East

Travel I-70 West, to the State Route 315 interchange. Follow State Route 315, North, to the Ackerman Road exit. Turn right from the exit onto Ackerman Road. Turn right onto Olentangy River Rd. Turn right onto Borror Dr. (Borror Dr. is the first right **past** the football facility). Camp parking lots are located on the right. Camp Staff will be available to direct you from the parking lots to camp check-in at the Woody Hayes Athletic Center.

From the West

Travel I-70 East, to the State Route 315 interchange. Follow State Route 315, North, to the Ackerman Road exit. Turn right from the exit onto Ackerman Road. Turn right onto Olentangy River Rd. Turn right onto Borror Dr. (Borror Dr. is the first right **past** the football facility). Camp parking lots are located on the right. Camp Staff will be available to direct you from the parking lots to camp check-in at the Woody Hayes Athletic Center.

From the North

Travel I-71 South, to the Interstate 270 interchange. Travel I-270, West, to the State Route 315 interchange (1.3 mi.). Follow State Route 315, South, to the Ackerman Road exit and turn left. Turn right onto Olentangy River Rd. Turn right onto Borror Dr. (Borror Dr. is the first right **past** the football facility). Camp parking lots are located on the right. Camp Staff will be available to direct you from the parking lots to camp check-in at the Woody Hayes Athletic Center.

From the South

Travel I-71 North, to the State Route 315 interchange. Follow State Route 315, North, to the Ackerman Road exit and turn right. Turn right onto Olentangy River Rd. Turn right onto Borror Dr. (Borror Dr. is the first right **past** the football facility). Camp parking lots are located on the right. Camp Staff will be available to direct you from the parking lots to camp check-in at the Woody Hayes Athletic Center.


