



General information

Under the southbound provisions of the Tasmanian Freight Equalisation Scheme (TFES), registered producers may claim assistance for raw materials, machinery and equipment shipped to Tasmania for use in manufacturing and mining processes. Assistance is only payable for goods of mainland Australian manufacture that incur a sea freight cost. Claimants must be the end users of commodities shipped. Freight forwarders and suppliers who are not end users are not eligible to claim.

Explanatory notes

- 1 Item**—Each item for which assistance is sought must be registered separately. General descriptions (e.g. hardware, essences, components) cannot be accepted – a schedule of items may be attached if necessary.
- 2 Use of item in process**—A general description to enable eligibility to be determined (e.g. flour, as a material input to bread making).
- 3 Name and address of mainland Australian manufacturer/supplier**—A letter from your supplier/manufacturer stating where the item was made must be submitted with your application. If the item is imported from overseas, the letter must detail any mainland Australian processing.
- 4 Details of freight paid**—If the freight cost is included in a Free into Store (FIS) price, the letter from your supplier/manufacturer must also detail the freight component.
