Phyllis Perry Hulton Educational Trust Scholarship

Phyllis Perry was a graduate of Marshalltown High School in 1942. She attended Marshalltown Business College. She worked as a personal secretary to the vice president of Sterling Steel Company in Pittsburgh. She married Kenneth Hulton. They did not have children. Phyllis retired in 1965 and later returned to Marshalltown. Phyllis died in 1994. In her will, she set up an Educational Trust and left money for her1942 classmates to use for their next reunion which was held in 1996.

Phyllis enjoyed people but had medical problems which limited her participation in class activities and class reunions. Her friendships though were important to her.

In her will, she also set up a Trust to provide educational scholarships for students after High School graduation. Last year the trustees awarded 103 scholarships. 38 were High School students in the amount of \$900.00 and 65 were college or technical school students in the amount of \$900.00.

Applications are comprised of the application form, college transcripts, the Educational Finance Planner, and an essay of 150 words or less. If you have less than a full year of college transcripts, please also send your High School transcripts.

Application Criteria:

The recipient must have graduated from a high school located in Marshall County.

The scholarships must be applied for annually.

The scholarships may be for the purposes of paying tuition, books, transportation and supplies but not room and board. Extra consideration will be given to an applicant who has had a physical handicap during their lifetime.
