2. Pay by Mail - Registration forms can also be mailed, along with a check, to the above locations.

3. Drop Box - For your convenience, a drop box is located beside the front door of the Rec. Adm. Bldg. and the Glenloch Recreation Center. You may leave a registration form with all information and fees included. Please **DO NOT** leave cash. Payment left in drop box after the 1st class begins must include a \$5 late fee. MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO PTC REC.

4. Charge Card - Use Visa or Master Card at Recreation Administration, The Gathering Place, or Kedron Fieldhouse & Aquatic Center, or on-line registration at www.ptcrecreation.org. If you enroll online there is a credit card convenience fee.

REGISTRATION RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Peachtree City residents may register starting the 15th of the month.
Fayette County and Out of County residents may register beginning on the 20th of each month.

OUT OF COUNTY REGISTRATION

- Any patron that resides "outside" of Fayette County limits is considered "Out of County" also known as a "Non-Resident" and an additional surcharge will apply to all patrons that reside "Out of County."

FEES AND PAYMENTS

- Fees must be paid **prior** to the first class of each session.
- A \$5.00 late fee will be assessed to people not registered before the first class.
- Registration will close and instructors cannot accept students after the second class of the session.

SENIOR DISCOUNT

- Some classes offered only for seniors (65 years or older) already reflect a discounted senior price and will be noted in the class description. For other classes **RESIDENTS MUST REQUEST THE DISCOUNT AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION.**

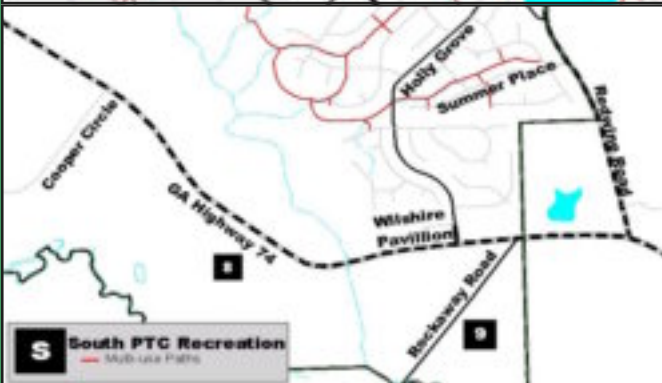
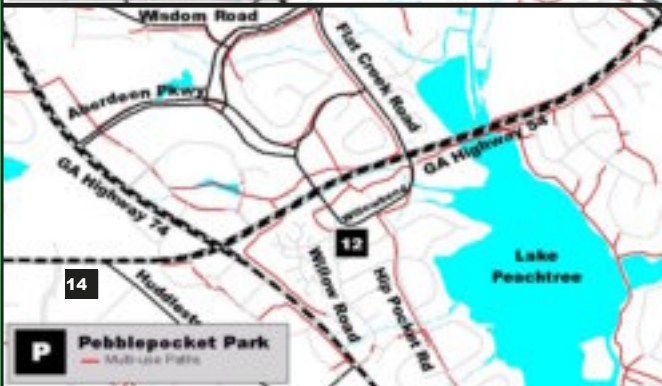
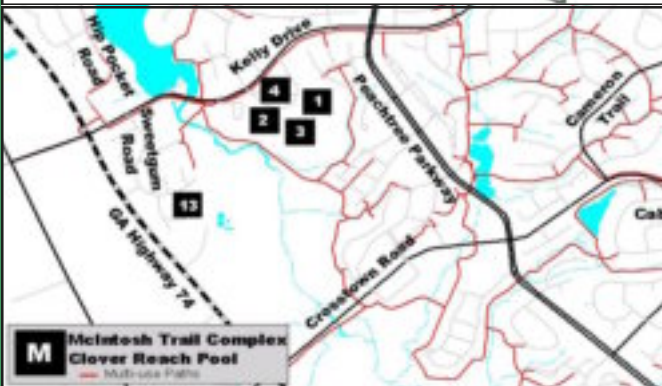
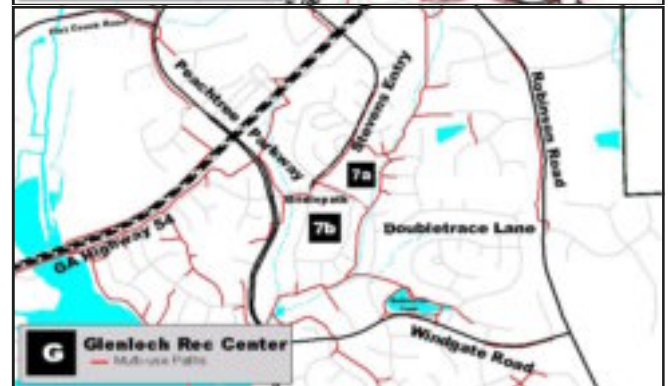
The Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel any class due to insufficient registration. If cancellation is necessary, anyone already registered will be so informed and a full refund shall be automatically issued and mailed to your residence.

If a written request is made to the Recreation Department before the class starts, a refund less 25% handling charge will be issued. After a class begins, refunds will be allowed **only** with a doctor's statement of the participant's incapacitating illness or injury. A written request for the refund must be accompanied by the doctor's statement. In this situation there will also be a 25% handling charge to process the refund. If you registered online, you will also lose the convenience fee associated with online registration.

- : Report all accidents to the pool manager.
- : All staff (PTC Rec. or USA Pool) has the right and responsibility to eject anyone from the pool and/or facility for misconduct in the pool.
