Information on how to fill out the application form

1. What you need to know

- In accordance with Article 30 of the Law of 21 March 2012 regarding waste, the
 establishments and undertakings ensuring the collection and transport of waste
 in the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg are subject to a permit issued by the Minister.
- The permit issued in the context of this application is only valid for collection or transport activities. This permit does not cover any other activities such as dealing or brokering waste. If you want to carry out these activities as well, you must submit a separate application form for dealers and brokers.
- In order to ensure the collection and transport of waste, you must be in possession of a contract
 - either with the producer of waste who has himself found a recipient for the waste; alternatively, this producer issues a certificate (f.ex. a letter) declaring his intention to employ your services in carrying the waste (EWC codes) in question;

- either with a waste dealer/broker licensed in Luxembourg; alternatively, this dealer/broker licensed in Luxembourg issues a certificate (f.ex. a letter) declaring his intention to take charge of the waste (EWC codes) carried by your company.
- These contracts and certificates are not required if you are yourself in possession of a
 permit for dealers and brokers for the waste that is the subject of this application.
- The explanations set forth hereunder are aimed at applicants with the purpose of helping them to fill out the application form.
- You must submit one copy of the application form to the address mentioned above.

2. What you need to be aware of

- The documents that you need to attach to this application form must be written in one of the following languages: Luxembourgish, French, or German. Any document written in another language shall be rejected, unless a translation is provided. For documents issued by the competent authority of a country that is not a member of the European Union, you must attach a certified translation.
- Applicants are allowed to submit copies of the documents that they must attach.
 However, for the following documents, the original or a certified copy must be submitted:
 - the criminal records / certificates of good conduct;
 - the certificates issued by the licensed dealers/brokers/producers;
 - > any other document issued by the competent authority of a country that is not a member of the European Union.
- Copies printed on thermal paper shall be rejected.
- You must initial every page of the application form, including the annexes and the documents to be attached.
- You must fill out the application form in block letters and you must attach the annexes to the corresponding chapters.

3. Filling out the form

Box 0

Choose as appropriate.

Box 1

Please fill in the information relating to your company. You must indicate the address of the company's headquarters (as recorded in the Registry of Commerce and Companies, where applicable).

Box 2 and Box 3

In this box, you must indicate the information relating to the company's general manager and his/her deputy. You must attach the criminal records of each person and you must attach them directly behind that page.

Box 4 and Box 5

In this box, you must indicate the information relating to the person responsible for overseeing the waste collection and transport activities and his deputy. You must attach the criminal records of each person and you must attach them directly behind that page.

Box 6

Under **point a)** you must indicate the number and date of the trade permit. You must attach a copy of the trade permit directly behind the page of point 6).

Under **point b)** you must indicate the date of establishment of the company. You must attach a copy of the document directly behind the page of point 6).

Under **point c)** you must indicate the number and date of the general liability insurance policy. You must attach a certificate by the insurance company proving the existence of the policy. This certificate must also mention that damages caused by the loading/unloading of the vehicle are covered.

Under **point d**) you must indicate the number and date of a permit issued by another EU member state. Moreover, you must attach a copy of this permit directly behind that page. If you do not possess such a permit, you must cross out section d).

Under **point e)** you must indicate the date of approval of the company's statutes. You must attach a copy of the statutes directly behind the page of point 6).

Box 7

The applicant must fill in and sign this box.

Annex 1

In this annex, you must list the types of waste that you would like to collect or carry.

Column 1) "Sequence N°" must indicate the sequence number (1, 2, 3 etc.).

Column 2) "EWC waste code" must indicate the waste code. Only the six-digit codes of the European Waste Catalogue (EWC) are allowed. However, the codes ending in '99' may only be used if there is no more appropriate code. If a code ending in '99' is indicated, the exact name of the waste (not the description of the EWC) must be indicated in column 3. If no other code is more appropriate, the code ending in '99' shall be reserved for the name indicated in column 3.

If you need several pages to fill in this information, please provide additional copies of the page as appropriate. In this case, you must indicate the page number at the top of the page. The applicant must initial every page of the annex.

Annex 2

In this annex, you must indicate the information relating to the means of transport.

Column 1 "Vehicle registration No" must indicate the number of the vehicle registration plate. You must attach a copy of the vehicle registration card directly behind Annex 2.

Column 2 "Vehicle type" must indicate the type of vehicle (f.ex. tractor, trailer, semi-trailer truck).

Column 3 "A.D.R. certificate valid until" must indicate the date of expiration of the A.D.R. certificate corresponding to the vehicle. You must attach a copy of each A.D.R certificate directly behind Annex 2. If you want to collect or carry only waste that does not fall within the scope of the A.D.R., you must note down "not applicable" in this column and you must initial the box.

Column 4 "Insurance N° of the vehicle" must indicate the number of the general liability insurance policy in question. You must attach a copy of each insurance policy directly behind Annex 2.

If you need several pages to fill in this information, please provide additional copies of the page as appropriate. In this case, you must indicate the page number at the top of the page. The applicant must initial every page of the annex.

Annex 3

Address:

In this annex, you must indicate the information relating to the transport containers.

Column 1 "Description" must indicate the type of container (f.ex. skip, leak-proof container, bulk container on a truck/trailer, etc.).

Column 2 "Waste category (sequence N° as in Annex 1)" must indicate the types of waste that will be carried in the container indicated in column 1 of the same row. This column must indicate the sequence number of the waste mentioned in column 1 of Annex 1.

Column 3 "Certificate of conformity" must indicate the number of the container's certificate of conformity. You must attach a copy of the container's certificate of conformity directly behind Annex 3.

Column 2 "Date of issue of the A.D.R. driving licence" must indicate the date of issue of the A.D.R. driving licence. You must attach a copy of the A.D.R. driving licence directly behind Annex 4.

Column 3 "Date of expiration of the A.D.R. driving licence" must indicate the date of expiration of the A.D.R. driving licence.

If you need several pages to fill in this information, please provide additional copies of the page as appropriate. In this case, you must indicate the page number at the top of the page. The applicant must initial every page of the annex.
