Alternative identification

If you don't have a valid driver's license, ID card or passport, send photocopies of three (3) different documents that include both **your name** and **current address**.

Expired documents are unacceptable.

Documents must be dated within the last 30 days and must have your current mailing address, this must match the address where the records will be mailed.

Alternative documents include:

- •Utility bill (for example: telephone, gas, electric, water, garbage removal) or other bill
- •Insurance statement, medical statement or paycheck stub
- Court or parole documents
- Valid work ID, unemployment statement, food stamp or other benefit cards (copy both sides)
- Permit for firearms, fishing, hunting or other license
- Vehicle registration, title or insurance statement, may be used
