Middlesex: 814,217 increase of 3%

Somerset: 324,893 0% change

Somerset: 79,587 decrease of 2%

Children receiving NJ SNAP (2008 – 2012)

Middlesex: 24,075 increase of 168%

Somerset: 5,920 increase of 143%

Middlesex: 314 decrease of 3%

Somerset: 176 decrease of 7%
