Information Regarding the Heritage Approval Process

The City of Thunder Bay has passed a bylaw in accordance with the Heritage Act, whereby any development, alteration, renovation or demolition on individually designated properties and any exterior renovation, alteration or demolition of buildings within the Waverly Park Heritage Conservation District requires review by the local Heritage Advisory Committee and approval of City Council.

A preliminary review of your application for a building permit indicates that the property/building in question is subject to such approval. To that end, an application must be made to the Heritage Advisory Committee, which reviews your proposal and considers that work in relation to heritage considerations. In doing so, the applicant is encouraged to make representation to the Committee that puts forth an argument supporting the work proposed. It is suggested that the use of photos showing the building as it currently exists, as well as graphic representation of the building's appearance after the proposed alteration are useful to the Committee in reviewing your application.

It is important to note that the accuracy, quality and amount of detail provided in your application are important factors in presenting your proposal. As you can appreciate, alterations that preserve the desired heritage aspect are likely to be looked at with more favour than proposals lacking this component.
