This is an application for Webster Youth Hockey's “**One Day...One Rink...One Champion**” Squirt Minor Travel Jamming Jamboree Tournament.

Premier teams from the Rochester surrounding area will compete in this inaugural event to be held October 9, 2010. Games will be played at Webster Ice Arena (Webster Youth Hockey's home rink) in Webster, New York, one of Western New York's premier hockey facilities.

### **TOURNAMENT SELECTION PROCESS**

**Your application does not guarantee acceptance into this tournament.**

Once your completed application and check are received by WYH, they will be reviewed by our selection committee. Selected teams for the tournament will be informed via e-mail or by written correspondence. If your team is not selected, your un-cashed check will be returned. It is our expectation to respond to your application by September 1st, 2010.

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### **TOURNAMENT RULES**

All rules established and published by USA Hockey shall apply, except as modified herein.

1. Any major penalty for fighting will result in an AUTOMATIC SUSPENSION from the tournament.
2. Any match penalty given will result in AUTOMATIC EXPULSION from the tournament for the guilty party. (Game misconduct penalties carry additional suspensions, refer to USA Hockey rules.)
3. All suspended coaching staff/players are NOT allowed on, near or behind the benches or otherwise allowed to participate in the game.
4. **In the event that a player is ejected from the game, a coach from the team's bench must escort the player to the locker room and remain with the player until custody is relinquished to a parent or guardian.**
5. **Any major penalty for fighting or any match penalty will result in automatic suspension from the tournament.**
6. Penalties will be 2:00 minors, 5:00 majors, and 10:00 misconducts.
7. Time of Periods: 12-10-12.
8. **All Games will have curfew clock.**
9. MERCY RULE: If five (5) or more goals separate the teams at the end of the second period, running time will commence for the remainder of the game. If the team from behind comes to within two goals of the team ahead, stop time will resume for the remainder of the game.
10. Internal mouth guards will be required. This rule cannot be waived and will be strictly enforced by the referees.
11. Referees are provided by the Rochester Ice Hockey Officials Association. Their decisions are final and Tournament Committee will not consider any protests of their decisions.
12. All championship/medal round games must be played. If a semifinal winner cannot stay for a championship game due to unforeseen reasons, the semi-final loser will take their place. The semi-final winner will forfeit all rights to any and all awards.
13. This is a USA Hockey sanctioned tournament. All players and teams must be recognized by the national bodies of the US (USA Hockey). The use of any illegal or unauthorized player will result in immediate expulsion from the tournament and the loss of all fees paid.
14. All players must sign in prior to their 1st game and coaches/manger must check in for all remaining games.
15. Standings will be based on total points: 3 points for a game win, and 1 point for each team in case of a tie.

**Each team will play two (2) qualifying games that will determine their standing in the eight (8) team tournament field:**

- 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> place teams in standings will play in 7<sup>th</sup> Place Game
  - 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> place teams in standings will play in 5<sup>th</sup> Place Game
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place teams in standings will play in Bronze Medal Game
  - 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams in standings will play in Gold Medal Game
16. In the event of a total points tie after two (2) preliminary games are completed, teams advancing to the finals will be determined by:
    - a. Head to head.
    - b. A ratio of goals for less against. The winner determined by the greatest surplus.
    - c. Total goals for.
    - d. Goals against.

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- e. Teams that scored the first goal (in games between each other).
  - f. Least penalties (major and minor only).
  - g. Coin Flip.
17. Players under suspension by USA Hockey are ineligible to participate in the tournament.
  18. Team must be prepared to begin a game up to fifteen minutes ahead of schedule. The team manager and coaches are responsible for ensuring the team is at the rink at the correct time. Failure to do so will result in the game being forfeited (1-0 score).
  19. **Game timing will commence with a 2:00 minute warm up, which will begin at the time the Zamboni doors close. All teams must be standing at their respective "door to the ice" as the Zamboni is exiting the ice. Teams not ready to play will forfeit their warm-up time.**
  20. Every Team is responsible for supplying a person for their own penalty box.
  21. Tiebreakers for Gold & Bronze Medal Games only, if game ends in a tie there will be a:
    - \* 5 minute sudden-death, overtime period and if still tied after overtime,
    - \* 3-player shoot-out will determine the winner.

Each team shall, prior to the start of the Gold & Bronze Medal games, select (3) three "shooters" to begin the shootout, and then list the rest of the team "shooters" in order. A shoot out consists of (1) player from each team per round shooting on the opposing goaltender. The home team will choose if they want to shoot first or last. The teams will begin alternating shooters and continue until all 3 shooters for each team have gone. The team with the most goals at the conclusion will be declared the winner.

In the event of a tie in the original 3 player shoot-out, the following format will be used to determine a winner, the next originally designated shooters will compete in a sudden death shoot-out (prior shooters are not eligible until all players have been used). The winner will be determined by each round. If there is no score or both teams score in a round, the next players for each team will shoot in the order they are on the list. This will continue until there is a goal differential in a round. At which point the winner will be declared.

22. The official game schedule shall be provided to the team before the start of the tournament/first game.
23. Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medal winners will receive team trophies.
  - \* All-Olympian Team selected by Coaches vote & Tourney Committee (F, F, F, D, D, G)
  - \* Each coach will submit 3 Players of the Game after each game.
24. **ZERO TOLERANCE FOR PLAYERS, COACHES, AND SPECTATORS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**
