\*If you are appealing regarding excessive credits (150%), explain the factor(s) that caused you to exceed the maximum credit limit AND include the completed audit sheet for your plan of study. The audit sheet MUST be signed by your academic advisor.

## STEP 4: COMPLETE PAGE 1 and 2 OF THIS FORM

STEP 5: SUBMIT YOUR COMPLETED APPEAL FORM, TYPED APPEAL LETTER AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS TO THE FINANCIAL AID OFFICE. MOST APPEALS TAKE APPROXIMATELY 2-3 WEEKS TO PROCESS.

Deadlines for Appeals: Fall 2014-August 15, 2014; Spring 2015-January 9, 2014; Summer 2015-May 22, 2015

Warning: Incomplete appeals will affect your ability to be considered for financial aid. Be sure that you have followed the above steps and submitted all appropriate documentation for your appeal. You will receive an e-mail at your VCCS e-mail address regarding the decision/status of your appeal.
