Instructions

The following documents must be submitted before an appeal will be considered:

Appeal of Denial Form – this document helps the applicant explain any extenuating circumstances or information that was not available at the time you applied for admission. Additional comments may be attached to the application.

Two completed Letter of Recommendation Forms – preferably from current or past teachers or professors. **Do not** include letters from family members, guardians or friends. <u>Appeal - Letter of Recommendation</u>

Updated Transcripts – high school or college transcripts that have current or updated grades. Unofficial transcripts or grade reports will be accepted.

Optional Requirement – supporting documentation to substantiate new and compelling information

Appeal Deadline – Complete appeal packets received by the 15th of each month will be forwarded to the sponsoring departments on the 16th. It is in your best interest to submit materials as soon as possible. Please visit the <u>Admission Appeals</u> page on our website for the final appeal deadline.
