What Do I Bring??

AARP Tax-Aide, a free program, provides income tax preparation assistance for low and middle-income taxpayers of all ages, with special attention to those 60 and older

Help from local counselors is given in Canton **EVERY Wednesday starting February 5 until April 9, 2014**Hour-long appointments begin @ 8AM; the last appointment @ 11AM **An appointment is required**

If married, both husband and wife should be present during an income tax counseling session. Taxpayers must have available all information and documents which have been received and which apply to their 2013 income taxes including:

- 1. Picture ID's
- 2. Copies of 2012 income tax forms
- 3. Social Security numbers OR Individual Taxpayer ID numbers for all household members
- 4. A check book so that any refund due can be direct deposited
- 5. All documents that relate to deductible expenses including total real estate taxes paid.
 - a. Real Estate Taxes
 - b. Car Taxes
- 6. All 2013 income report forms that have been received:
 - a. SSA-1099, Social Security Benefit Statement and RRB-1099-R, US Railroad Retirement Board forms
 - b. All 1099 form (1099-INT, 1099-OID, 1099-DIV, 1099-R, 1099-B, 1099-S,1099-MISC)
 - c. W-2, Wage and Tax Statement forms
 - d. W-2G, Certain Gambling Winnings forms
 - e. Original cost of assets sold during 2013.
