

Welcome to Cantabella Children's Chorus 2012 Summer Camp

Choral, Rhythm and Movement Camp: Musicianship Made Fun!

WELCOME to the **Cantabella Children's Chorus** summer camp. In this registration packet, you will find the information and forms you need to register your child for the 2012 summer camp of Cantabella. Please read the entire packet completely prior to completing the registration and payment forms. CLASSES AND FEES

- Dates: Monday through Friday, July 16—27, 2012
- Location: Valley Community Church (4455 Del Valle Parkway, Pleasanton)
- A \$55.00 non-refundable camp deposit due upon registration. There is a \$20 discount for early payment of the remaining balance (before 5/19) for 2 week camp, and \$10 savings for the one week camp.
- Refunds (beyond the deposit) will only be given when chorister requests in writing before 6/18/12.
- Fees include all class materials, a Cantabella 20th Anniversary t-shirt, and a demonstration performance on the last day of camp.

Two Week Camp, July 16—27th, is recommended as it will be progressive and culminate in a class demonstration/performance at the end of two weeks:

COURSES

Each group will attend three rotations each day to develop musicianship skills:

- **Choral and Music Literacy:** Choristers work to develop music literacy, healthy vocal techniques and choral artistry using Kodaly's concept of music education. Through this method, campers will be introduced to rhythm symbols and syllables, hand signs, and the moveable "DO" solfa—do, re, mi, fa, so, la, ti. Camp students will also sing and memorize fun, developmentally appropriate songs to help develop their ability to sing in a choir.
- **Rhythm Exploration and Development:** Students will explore various aspects of rhythm and vocal awareness through the use of fun, dynamic exercises taught by a registered Music Together instructor. The class will have an opportunity to play a variety of percussion instruments to develop a sense of rhythm and group musicianship. Both small and large rhythmic movement will be experienced through the use of rhythmic games and group dances to encourage a sense of time, tempo, and phrasing.
- **Expressive Movement and Dance:** Basic principles of movement and dance are explored. Students work balance and coordination while learning to move with musicality and grace. Students will experience the body's connection to self and space through dance warm ups, stretches, and basic steps. Dance skills which support choral choreography are emphasized, and students will learn movement routines to choir songs learned in camp.

The final day of camp, students will perform songs, rhythm, and movement skills for parents with an informal class demonstration!
