Instructions: To determine the initial average weekly wage for an employee, the gross earnings for the 12 months prior to the accident should be used. If the employee has worked less than 12 months, the earnings for the time worked should be used. The earnings for similar employees may be used if the employee has worked less than 60 days.

When filling out the form, place a check mark in the box for each day worked. Paid vacations and paid holidays should also be marked the same way.

Note that these earnings are GROSS earnings and include overtime and tips, before any deductions are made for taxes or social security. If there was any perquisites provided, please list the TOTAL value separately at the bottom of the chart.
