## TAKE NOTICE THAT

1. This is now a defended claim.
2. It appears that this case is suitable for allocation to the fast track.

If you believe that this track is not the appropriate track for the claim, you must complete box D2 on the Directions Questionnaire (Form N181) and explain why.

3. You must by / /

a) complete the Directions Questionnaire (Form N181), file it with the court office and serve copies on all other parties

and b) attempt to agree directions with all other parties

and c) file proposed directions (whether or not agreed) with the Directions Questionnaire.

4. By the same date, the allocation fee of £  is due. this is payable by the claimant, unless proceeding on a counterclaim only.

Following further notice, if the allocation fee is not paid by the date due the claim/counterclaim will be automatically struck out.
