IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Welcome to Syracuse University. The staff of the Slutzker Center is here to assist you and answer questions regarding your rights and responsibilities as an international student.

AS AN INTERNATIONAL STUDENT:

- You must maintain full time student status. As a general rule, this means enrolling in at least 9 credits each semester (graduate) or 12 credits each semester (undergraduate);
- Please contact our office before starting any job or employment opportunity. International students must receive work authorization from our office except for on campus jobs.
- Please contact our office before you travel outside the US. A travel signature is required on your I-20 or DS-2019 for you to return to the United States.
- Know your program end date on your I-20 or DS-2019. This is the date by which you should complete your degree. Please contact our office **before** this date if you need more time to finish your degree.
- Keep your I-94 Card in your passport If you received the small white I-94 card when you entered the United States, please keep it in your passport.

HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE

The Slutzker Center recommends that you (and your dependents in the US) purchase student health insurance coverage to cover unexpected medical expenses while you are in the United States. Policy information and applications are available at the Slutzker Center.

Teaching Assistants, Research Assistants or Graduate Assistants (TA, RA, GA) are employees of the University, and can participate in the University employee insurance plans. In addition, it is necessary for TA, RA, and GAs to purchase *medical evacuation and repatriation insurance*.
