The Topic: **Fatigue in the 24-Hour society: What advice should we be giving to management?**

The Speaker: **Libby Brook** BPsych, MAppPsych (Occupational)

Libby's past research has focused on fatigue levels in shiftworkers in the mining industry. It focused on analysing different shift patterns, looking at reaction time, errors, and subjective lifestyle factors and their impact on fatigue levels. Currently, she is looking at the impact of leave duration on recovery of sleep debt as well as comparing the subjective need for sleep with actual alertness. Before being appointed as a lecturer in the postgraduate organisational psychology stream at Murdoch University, Libby worked in counselling and employee relations roles, and then became the inaugural Recruitment Psychologist for the Prisons Division of the Department of Corrective Services. She is a Psychology Officer in the Army Reserves and within this role provides counselling, conduct screening assessments, training and expert advice to Commanders on operational issues. She also provides consultancy services in public safety screening and in fatigue-related issues.
