## **Mission Moment - Prayers for Liberia**

The Ministry of Health and Social Welfare of Liberia reported an outbreak of Ebola virus in Liberia. The outbreak is a spillover from the Guinea Forest Region. The Ganta Hospital where our missionary, Dr. Albert Willicor, is Chief Medical Officer, is located just across the border of Guinea. Two suspected cases of Ebola appeared at Ganta Hospital. Both cases were transferred to other hospitals. Ebola is virulent and



spreads rapidly in healthcare settings where hospital staffs like Ganta Hospital are not fully equipped and protected. Please keep Ganta Hospital and all of that area in your prayers as UMCOR works with the Hospital and the health board to combat this problem.
