

In the Department of Radiology and Nuclear Medicine at the Otto-von-Guericke University Magdeburg, the position of a

W2-Chair of Radiological Microtherapy (part time Professorship in Interventional Radiology)

is vacant. The position is to be filled at the earliest possible opportunity and is for a fixed term of 5 years. The post-holder will represent the fields of medical care, research and education.

The Professorship will be combined with a third-party funded post of the director of an Academy for Microtherapy which will be founded at the University of Magdeburg.

A medical degree, a national board certification as a Radiologist, as well as a postdoctoral qualification or similar scientific performance are the preconditions of employment. In addition to interventional radiology the post-holder must also represent diagnostic radiology in its complete range. Required are international publications, experience in conducting clinical trials and successful acquisition of third-party funds. Furthermore, applicants with experience in the development of medical tools as well as knowledge in business administration are in demand.

Active participation within joint projects in the field of medical technology of the Otto-von-Guericke University is expected.

In order to increase the proportion of female staff members at the Otto-von-Guericke University, applications from female scientists are particularly encouraged. Handicapped applicants will be given preference in case of equal qualifications.
