Mission Statement

Statement of Faith

Cornerstone Prep is a non-denominational Christian school dedicated to help Christian parents fulfill their Biblical mandate to educate their children in the Lord. To that end, all subjects are taught from a Christian worldview. Bible classes emphasize learning to study scripture, to interpret it accurately, and to apply its truths to every area of life.

Cornerstone Prep focuses on these essential elements of the Christian faith:

- All Scripture is inspired by God and is His infallible Word, inerrant in its original manuscripts.
- There is only one God who exists in three distinct persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- Man, created in the image of God, is both a physical and spiritual being.
- Man sinned, resulting in the loss of fellowship with God.
- Jesus Christ was fully God and fully man, born to a virgin by the power of the Holy Spirit, came to earth and lived among men.
- Though sinless, He was put to death to save us from eternal death and suffering, the just penalty for our sins.
- On the third day He physically rose from the dead, and will one day return to judge the world and deliver His people.
- Salvation from sins is accomplished only by faith in Christ, which is a gift of grace from God.
- The Holy Spirit regenerates new believers and empowers them for righteous living and service.
- Jesus Christ is the head of the church, which is composed of His believers. He instructed them to go make disciples of all nations.

Students are encouraged to discuss questions of doctrine with their parents and church leaders, partners with the Christian school in equipping them for righteous living.

Enrollment Philosophy- the Culture of Cornerstone Prep

Enrollment at Cornerstone Prep is selective. Our goal is to help you achieve academic excellence, even if you have struggled with that in the past. Our school is for students who are also willing to grow as Christ-followers, to support the mission of the school and contribute positively to our culture by:

- Developing a positive attitude and cooperative, encouraging spirit toward others
- Setting personal goals and working hard to achieve them- body, mind and soul
- Participating in extracurricular activities
- Consistently showing respect for students, staff, and others

- Maintaining cheerful, faithful compliance with all school policies including the uniform dress code, electronic device use, etc.
- Exhibiting standards of Christian behavior both in and outside of school in word and deed

Initial and continued enrollment is conditional upon a student's commitment to maintaining these standards in attitude and behavior.

The culture of Cornerstone Prep is what makes our school unique and effective. It explains why some students drive/carpool an hour a day to get here. The most significant difference you will find between Cornerstone Prep and public high schools is displayed in our logo- Veritas et virtus (truth and virtue). We believe that:

- Truth- exists and that it was revealed to us in the person of Jesus Christ
- Virtue- people who understand that truth behave differently

We expect that our students are already followers of Christ, and will behave differently, to treat one another with love and forgiveness and to encourage one another as the scriptures command. To those who may honestly be struggling with what you believe, we are not asking you to accept someone else's beliefs but ask that you agree to live by our standards of conduct and keep an open mind as you study the scriptures and learn more about what it means to be a disciple of Jesus Christ. All Christian high schools are not alike. Cornerstone Prep's mission is to develop disciples of Jesus, but since all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, it is necessary that as faithful disciples we learn to live out the grace of God. Grace is "unmerited favor" or getting good stuff you don't deserve. But the grace you'll find here isn't cheap grace. That means we take seriously our responsibility to bear the name of Jesus Christ in a way that reflects his truth. So, you'll find that we have certain rules you must live by while enrolled. Some are rules that we strongly believe are biblical mandates and others are what we call institutional preferences. We've established as few as possible but are firm with the ones we've decided upon, because the way our students live is the greatest testimony to truth that we have to offer the world.

It is important for your personal safety and the unity of the student body that we agree to certain values that allow us to live in harmony and peace. When you enroll at Cornerstone Prep you are agreeing to abide by our school rules as listed in the handbook while you are on school property and even when you are not. In each instance where a member of the student body steps outside these boundaries of appropriate behavior, applying abundant grace is our clear goal. This does not preclude us from taking whatever disciplinary measures are necessary to protect both the student and the student body, unfortunately including expulsion if necessary. We all represent Jesus Christ when we bear the name Christian, and have joint responsibility to represent Him and our school very well, protecting our collective reputations as diligently as we strive to protect our individual reputations.

We promise to take time to help you understand our biblical philosophy. There are always amazing benefits and some will just blow you away. And we'll even make a good case for the institutional preferences. We don't want to have rules for the sake of rules. We'd rather focus on the good stuff God has for you!

Each student will have a designated mentor who's committed to encouraging you with truth and love. They will meet with you regularly to see how you're feeling about life, school, family and God. If you are struggling with any specific standards of conduct or sin of any type, you can talk confidentially to your mentor. It is our goal to help you break free of anything that causes you to struggle, rather than encourage you to hide problems that could be solved with a little help.

Tuition, Financial Aid & Scholarships

Cornerstone Prep is committed to academic excellence, which necessitates a long-term commitment to qualified, dedicated faculty and an ongoing investment in their continuing education. We heartily endorse the Christian high school experience as the final significant academic journey before teens are released as legal adults into the care, custody and control of post-secondary educators. Parental investment in assuring their teens' competence as Godly critical-thinking scholars is therefore priceless and of lifelong value.

Knowing this, we also realize that college is on the horizon for the majority of our students, and pledge to strive for the balance required to maintain academic excellence without excluding those who will both bless others and be blessed by their attendance at Cornerstone Prep.

- We pledge to make every effort to keep tuition affordable, including the availability of tuition payment plans, financial aid, and scholarships so that every mission-appropriate student who desires a Cornerstone Prep education has the financial resources available to make it possible.
- We will strive to provide an environment of academic study and extracurricular activities that is rigorous and effective so that capable students who work diligently can qualify for college scholarships and college credits based on above average performance, successful completion of college prep and AP classes, high class rank and scores on PSSA, SAT and ACT tests, as well as qualifying for athletic, fine arts, music and other scholarships.

Tuition for the full 2012-2013 academic year is \$6,200.00

We understand that many families have "mission appropriate" students who want to attend Cornerstone Prep, but based on family income and other circumstances, cannot afford it. The fact is that those children and families can be a valuable asset to our school, and that is where we want to help.

If tuition appears to be more than you can afford based on income or other special circumstances, we have several options that may be available to your family:

- Financial aid from state tax credit scholarships (based on income and # children in the family)
- Other scholarships
- Opportunities for student/family to earn significant tuition discounts through service to the school and participation in fund-raising activities. One easy program that everyone can participate in is the scrip program that provides income for tuition or extracurricular charges. It involves use of pre-paid gift cards that can be used anywhere- Walmart, VISA card, Giant Eagle, SAMS Club, gasoline, department stores, etc. The cards are purchased for the same amount you would have spent anyway, so this is a perfect way to raise money without paying more for marked up items. It also offers families not requesting tuition support an opportunity to participate and be a blessing to others in need without an out of pocket contribution.

If requesting financial aid or scholarships:

- 1. Complete the Cornerstone Prep Tuition Options Application and submit it confidentially to Mrs. Cindi McCall by mail or fax as soon as possible to the address/fax # below.
- 2. Complete the Private School Aid Service paper application. Make sure that you keep a copy of the PSAS application for your records and mail the original in the envelope (included with the application) and your check for \$23 to cover the PSAS processing fee.

Completed applications will be reviewed promptly and the expected family contribution pre-confirmed at your request, prior to submitting your child's enrollment application. The Board of Directors' Financial Aid Committee will review and approve applicants based on necessitous/anonymous details provided by Mrs. McCall.

Tuition & Fee Payment Policy

Tuition/Payment Options- All tuition payments begin July 1 (except late enrollments) but we offer several payment options, some enabling discounts. Please choose one.

- Option #1- Full Payment by July 1, 2012 with a 2% discount- \$ 6,076.00
- **Option #2** Half Payments by July 1, 2012 and January 1, 2013 with a 1% discount-\$ 6,138.00 (2 payments of \$ 3069.00)
- Option #3- 10 Monthly Payments from July 30, 2012 April 30, 2013- \$ 620.00
- Option #4- 12 Monthly Payments from July 30, 2012 June 30, 2013- \$516.67
- **Option #5** 12 Monthly Payments from July 30, 2012- June 30, 2013- (see amount listed per item 1.b. on Tuition Options Application)

All monthly payments will be remitted through Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) on the 5th day of the month by FACTS Management. Families may register securely online or via paper applications for the automatic monthly tuition deductions. To register online- go to

Additional Fees/Payment Options-

- Soccer/Girls Volleyball/Basketball Participation: \$150 per student per sport

- Fees for Lost or Damaged Books, Uniforms, or other property: as charged

Additional fees are charged at the time student registers for the sport/event, regardless of whether they finish the season. Fund-raising options will be offered to students to help offset their cost of participation.

Student Withdraw/Tuition Reduction/Refunds:

Decisions regarding budgets for staffing, books, etc. are made based on anticipated enrollment. It is rarely possible to replace a student who chooses to leave mid-year. For that reason, partialyear students pay the full semester tuition amount for any semester they participate in. It is your decision as to when you enter or leave, so please consider this before you make your entrance or exit plans. If your reason for considering leaving is based on a change of financial circumstances, please speak to Mrs. McCall about emergency support. For students who withdraw mid-year, report cards and transcripts will be sent to the student's new school when all tuition for the semesters attended and fees due are paid in full.

If you happen to move out of our service area unexpectedly mid-year, your tuition will be due for any month that you attended. Report cards and transcripts will be sent to the student's new school when all tuition and fees due are paid in full.
