## Pittsburgh Amateur Hockey League PAHL Scholarship Application

Dear Applicant,

The Pittsburgh Amateur Hockey League will be awarding scholarships to deserving players who exhibit qualities of leadership, sportsmanship, academic success, and the desire to strive for the future. In order to be considered for this award, you must meet the following criteria:

- a. Last year of eligibility in amateur hockey through PAHL
- b. A QPA of 3.50 or higher (on a 4.0 scale)
- c. Plan to attend an institution to further your education

The enclosed application and essays must be completed and mailed to the Committee Chairperson no later than **April 5, 2014**. Any application which is incomplete or postmarked beyond due date will not be considered. Each applicant must list the last four digits of his/her Social Security number on the top of each page. This allows for anonymity for those evaluating the essays.

The evaluation committee will be comprised of a committee of educators and a select member of the PAHL Board. In the event of a tie during scoring, two additional educators will be asked to participate in the evaluation process. Essays will be evaluated according to originality, content, grammar, sentence structure, and spelling. One short answer essay must be 50 words or less. The other two essays must be 250 words or less. The essays are very important in the final evaluation of scholarships. A rubic is used to help in the scoring process.

## Essays must be:

- a. Double spaced and typed
- b. Allow for one inch margin on the left hand side and bottom of page
- c. Place your last 4 digits of your Social Security number on the top of the page

The following required documents must be enclosed for your application to be considered by the scholarship committee. Please forward ALL requested materials in the same envelope.

- a. Completed application
- b. Essays
- c. Official high school transcript
- d. SAT, ACT scores
- e. Two letters of recommendation (family members are excluded)

Each letter of recommendation should be sent in a separate sealed envelope with the other required documents. Individuals writing the letter of recommendation are requested to sign their names across the sealed portion of the envelope. Recommendations from school personnel should be on district letterhead.
