Explanatory Notes:

- A separate confirmation must be completed for each customer (e.g. joint holders, trustee cases and joint life cases). Where a third party is involved, e.g. a payer of contribution who is different from the customer, the identity of that person must also be verified, and a confirmation provided.
- This form cannot be used to verify the identity of any customer that falls into one of the following categories:
 - those who are exempt from verification as being an existing client of the introducing firm prior to the introduction of the requirement for such verification;
 - those whose identity has not been verified by virtue of the application of the permitted exemption under the Money Laundering Regulations; or
 - those whose identity has been verified using the source of funds as evidence.
- This confirmation must carry an original signature, or an electronic equivalent.
