#### **Loss of Former Township Secretary-Treasurer**

#### PA Supreme Court Order Changing Township Magisterial District

On January 31, 2013, the PA Supreme Court of Common Pleas issued an order changing the coverage for Tyrone Township from District Court 51-3-01 to 51-3-03 effective April 1, 2013. This means that individuals residing in Tyrone Township should be aware of the change in resolving private complaints, eligible civil proceedings and landlord-tenant disputes. Traffic and criminal filings for alleged offenses should be filed in District Court 51-3-03.

#### Materials Accepted at Tyrone Township Recycling Center

As a reminder, the Tyrone Township Recycling Center collects the following: tin and aluminum cans, newspapers, clear and colored glass, cardboard, clothing textiles and plastic containers numbered 1 or 2 marked on the bottom. **Materials not listed are not accepted!** The Recycling Center is open the 2nd and 4th Saturday of the month from 9 AM to 11 AM.

#### **Community Fire Company Events**

Heidllersburg Fire Company will be holding their benefit dinners the 3rd Saturday of the month—April 20. Heidlersburg 's Annual Fire Company Carnival will be held August 15, 16 & 17.

Bendersville Community Fire Company benefit dinners will be held the 4th Saturday in April and May (April 27 and May 25). #### Tips for Conducting a Safe Controlled Burn

The following safety tips are recommended since there is presently no County burn ban:

- Burn a minimum of 50 feet from any structure
- Clear the area of any overhead obstructions or trees
- Do not allow potential runoff to flow into any public waterway
- Do not leave fire unattended
- Do not use gasoline to start the fire
- Have an ample water supply to control or extinguish the fire or heavy equipment that may be used
- Make sure you have a reliable means of contacting 9-1-1
- Mow a 50-foot area around burn site
- Only burn at a humidity level of 25% or greater
- Request an inspection of the burn site from a fire marshal deputy.

As summer approaches, you may want to check with the Adams County Emergency Services at 334-8603 if a burn ban is in effect.
