- All new Councilmen were invited to meeting for introductions and were given a description of Councilman Duties, Councilman Ushering Duties, list of Boards and Duties of Boards.
- Outgoing Councilmen were thanked for their services and new Councilmen were welcomed.
- A new updated Budget for Voters' meeting was approved.
- A motion was made and seconded to allow our members to loan money to St. John at an interest rate (to be agreed upon) up to 4%. This will be voted on at the June 22nd Voters meeting.
- Update on Hearing Aid Loop system installation. Installer didn't recommend cutting our carpet in church to install. A motion was made and seconded <u>not</u> to install the hearing aid system at church at this time.
- Membership Changes In: Rita Ayala by transfer from St. Paul's, Lake Mills. Membership Changes Out: Megan (Sussek) Schaning requested a release.
- Motion was made and seconded to allow a garage sale in the school gymnasium on Wiener & Kraut day. Tina Holzhueter and Kelly Kuhl will organize the sale. Motion carried.
- Motion was made and seconded to start a family S'Mores Campfire Bible Study starting July 30th. Motion carried.
- Properties Board is looking into blacktopping north end of school parking lot, condensation pump on west heater in church has been fixed, and they will be working on a hearing aid system for church.
- Next Council meeting will be held on Tuesday, August 12th, at 7:00 PM

- Council recommends to drop the Monday night regular service during Lent. Motion passed.
- General Fund Budget was tabled until Voters' Meeting resumes in June.
