Scholarship Application Package

A. General Information

The Virgil C. Webb, William Garber and Flora Webb Garber Foundation ("Foundation") was initiated to benefit deserving and financially needy students from Bondurant-Farrar High School. The scholarships are awarded each year to deserving high school seniors who plan to attend a four-year college. The applicant must principally reside in the Bondurant-Farrar Community School District.

Applicants are asked to submit a completed application by March 1st of each year. The application will be reviewed by the Managing Directors and approved by the Board of Directors of the Foundation. The Foundation Directors will approve the awards and the winners will be notified during the Bondurant-Farrar High School senior awards night or by mail for awards to current college/university students.

Only complete applications will be considered. The completed application consists of:

- 1. Completed Virgil C. Webb, William Garber and Flora Webb Garber Foundation Scholarship Application (use additional paper as necessary) (form included)
- 2. Official transcript of your high school grades sent by Bondurant-Farrar High School or copy from college/university (see Consent to Release of Grades and Academic Information)
- 3. Letter of recommendation from high school principal (form included)
- 4. Letter of recommendation from a high school teacher (form included)
- 5. Personal letter of recommendation (form included)
- 6. An original essay on the why the applicant should be considered for the scholarship
- 7. Complete list of any certificates, honors or awards you have received
- 8. Other relevant information to support your application
- 9. Consent to Release of Grades and Academic Information

Applications must be postmarked no later than March 1, of each year and received by March 5 of each year. Mail completed applications to: Virgil C. B. Virgil C. Webb

Virgil C. Webb was a life-long resident of Bondurant, Iowa. He farmed his family farm and eventually was the rural postal carrier later in his life. He enjoyed music by singing

in church and for others. He was known for his generosity by giving away his sweet corn and his garden products, all renowned for their taste, quality and size. Later in his years, Virgil lost the ability to hear music or sing. He then realized he would not outlive his investments and requested his family holdings be invested in the Bondurant community. His first concern was for graduates from Bondurant-Farrar High School who wanted to go to college for music and had financial limitations. He was also concerned for needy and deserving graduates of Bondurant-Farrar High School, who wish to attend a four-year college or university majoring in something other than music and who could not afford to do so without financial assistance.

C. Award Amounts

Award amounts vary with each student. Students who qualify will be awarded funds, which may cover tuition and fees for up to 30 credit hours per academic year, but at a minimum of 12 hours per semester (full time designation). The amount of the award is credited to the student's account during the first two months of classes after being calculated during the registration periods. The Managing Directors supervise these student award accounts. If a student drops below full time designation, or drops from the college or university during the refund period, the Foundation will request a refund of the scholarship from the college/university. Awards are given on a year-to-year basis. A student in good standing who has fulfilled previous award obligations may apply each year for the award. Preference will be given first to high school graduates and then to college students requesting a renewal of the award or a new application for existing college student. Any unused scholarships awarded to the student and paid to the university/college will be refunded to the Foundation.

D. Obligations

College students receiving this scholarship will be expected to fulfill the academic responsibility of the award. Students may re-apply for this award so long as they have lived up to the conditions of the award and there are funds available by the Foundation. The following factors may be grounds for discontinuing the award: the inability of the student to work harmoniously with faculty and/or fellow students; the student's failure to maintain minimum grade point average; the student's failure to make significant progress toward a degree; or a serious violation of the law or of Bondurant-Farrar High School or college/university policies and regulations. The Board of Directors of the Foundation reserves the right to refuse renewal in any of the above cases.

To maintain eligibility for the Foundation Scholarship, you must:

- Maintain a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.25 in all coursework
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 in all coursework of your major
- Enroll in a four-year college or university
- Carry a full academic load of at least 12 credit hours per semester
- Continue to be a student in good standing by abiding to the policies of the Bondurant-Farrar High School Student Handbook and/or the college or university
- Fulfill the academic responsibilities of the award

Provide semester grade results to the Managing Directors of the Virgil C. Webb,
 William Garber and Flora Webb Garber Foundation within 45 days of semester's end

Students may request their award to be renewed so long as they have lived up to the conditions of the award, re-apply, qualify for the scholarship annually, and Foundation funds are available. The following factors may be grounds for discontinuing the award: the inability of the student to work harmoniously with faculty and/or fellow students; the student's failure to maintain minimum grade point average; the student's failure to maintain standards of excellence and progress in his/her major; the student's failure to make significant progress toward a degree; or a serious violation of the law or of Bondurant-Farrar High School or college/university policies and regulations. The Managing Directors reserves the right to refuse renewal in any of the above cases.

The Virgil C. Webb, William Garber and Flora Webb Garber Foundation does not discriminate on the grounds of disability, age, race, color, religion, sex, ethnic origin, or any other classification protected by Federal and/or Iowa state constitutional and/or statutory law.
