

## MARYSVILLE ROCK AND GEM CLUB SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION For Spring Quarter 2011

The Marysville Rock and Gem Club Inc. is a non-profit lapidary Club. In support of education and to further understanding of our hobby, the Club has elected to establish a Scholarship Fund to assist a <u>sophomore student</u> (who has between 45 and 90 credits) and is enrolled with a major in a geology or earth science-related program at a local college or university.

## Eligibility

Any such qualified student enrolled in a regular college or university earth sciences curriculum shall be eligible to apply during Fall Quarter of the academic year. Application forms must be returned to the Scholarship Committee (in their hands) *by NOV. 30, 2010*. This year's Scholarship will be for the sum of \$500 and will be available to the scholarship recipient for Spring (2011) Quarter.

The following criteria will be considered by the Scholarship Committee:

- 1. Scholarship (include current transcript from college)
- 2. Goals
- 3. Need
- 4. Intent to continue studies in the earth sciences
- 5. References (2 letters- 1 being from an instructor- and not from relatives to be included)
