

AIM Application Instructions 2014 / 15

Recommended Indicators of Success -

Students need to meet the following criteria in order to be successful in the AIM program:

Measure Criteria

1. Advanced reading ability, as measured by: TCAP Reading Proficient Hi or above

Reading MAP Very High

2. Advanced writing ability as measured by: TCAP Writing Proficient Hi or above

3. Task commitment, as measured by: Achievement Status 3's or better on core subjects

(reading, writing, ss, science)

4. Internal motivation, as measured by: Writing sample Evidence of planning,

editing, attention to detail

To apply, assemble *all* of the following:

- a completed student information sheet
- a copy of the student's most recent report card
- a completed, handwritten writing sample (attach any plans, drafts, revisions, etc.)
- students new to the district or to the Liberty attendance area must also provide proof of advanced reading and writing ability (preferably standardized test scores)

It is the responsibility of the applicant to include all of the components listed above.

Placement decisions will be based on the most recent data available to ensure that all students are appropriately placed. Therefore, emails regarding acceptance into the AIM program will be sent in August after review of the most recent TCAP scores.
