Major Changes Must Be Made to the NEWGLSF 40th <u>Annual Banquet</u> <u>Saturday Evening March 8, 2014</u>

The 40th Annual N.E.W.G.L.S.F. Spring Banquet will be held at the City Limits, formerly the Club Bil-Mar on Saturday, March 8, 2014. We will start with cocktail hour beginning at 4:30 and the meal will be served promptly at 6:30 p.m. The fun starts after the meal with raffles, ½ the pot, guns, auction, silent auction and lots of Dinner Raffle Prizes, (formerly the Door Prizes) will be given out at the Banquet. Jack and Carol Resch at 682-0508 are again running the banquet. If any members are interested in helping or donating prizes, please call Jack and Carol. The more people that help the easier it is... We always set up for the banquet at the Bil-Mar at 9:00 a.m. that Saturday and if anyone can help, please come. Dinner Ticket prices are \$25.00 per person before the banquet and \$40.00 after March 3rd or at the door.

Those of you who have attended our banquet in the past, you know it is like Christmas. The majority of the Dinner Raffle Prizes, formerly the Door Prizes will have a value of at least \$25.00 or approximately the cost of your dinner ticket. Please help the committee by getting a donation or two for the banquet. If you do not want to go out and collect donations, at least think about donating an item yourself as an extra bottle of wine or liquor for the Banquets Basket of Booze Raffle, or a Gift Certificate to a local restaurant. The number of Dinner Raffle Prizes will depend upon the number of donations from our members and the various businesses.

We are again shooting for <u>200 Dinner Raffle Prizes</u>, (formerly the door prizes) and about 150 Red and Green Raffle Prizes. The Board of Directors and other volunteers are busy asking for donations and buying prizes. If you are a Business Sponsor or just a Great Lakes Sport Fishermen and would like to donate a gift or two please contact Jack and Carol Resch at 682-0508.

"HERE ARE THE REQUIRED RAFFLE CHANGES"

- 1. Class B Raffle Tickets Cannot Be Mailed or Purchased Before the Day of the Event.
- 2. Penny Raffles are now illegal This will be replaced with a New \$.99 Cent Raffle.
- 3. The 200+ Door Prizes we had in the past, based on the purchase of the Dinner Ticket are also illegal. This will be replaced with the purchase of a <u>Single Raffle Ticket for \$2.00</u>, after showing your dinner ticket the night of the Banquet. This will make sure that we are legal according to the State and that only one Dinner Raffle Prize can be won by a single individual.
- 4. The Raffle Packages we have been providing our people the past years, where you paid \$60.00 for a \$110.00 worth of raffle tickets in the Early Raffle Package are also illegal. You are not allowed to sell raffle tickets in advance of the day of the event. This regulation, we feel, will impact the net income of the Northeast Spring Banquet. A new package available see below.
- 5. The State will permit us to sell raffle tickets at different prices like we have in the past, depending upon the raffle; like so many tickets for a Dollar, or so many tickets \$5.00, or so many tickets for \$10.00 and we can still use the Arms Length as long as the Arms Length has the same number of tickets. The big issue is the tickets we put into the package for a raffle must be the same price as what they are sold for the night of the Banquet.
- 6. Since everything needs to be sold and ripped apart the night of the Banquet, this will all take more time.
- 7. No guns can be claimed by anyone under the age of 18 and you must be 21 to claim any prize containing an alcoholic beverage.

SPECIAL NOTE: The Banquet Committee is extremely worried that the new laws regarding Raffles will seriously decrease the net profit margin of the Club's Main Fund Raiser – Our Spring Banquet. We have always sold Dinner Tickets along with an Early Raffle Package. The sale of these 150 early packages permitted the committee to purchase prizes without going into our savings. The funds generated from our Banquet are used to keep the rearing pond and all of the clubs other activities going strong. These past 150 package holders would still come to the Banquet and purchase other raffle tickets for some of the raffles not found in the old package. Unfortunately now everything must be paid for the day of the banquet and we feel this may create a financial strain on some of our members. We sure hope everyone will make allowances and prove us wrong. The committee is going all out to get the very best prizes we can to make the 2014 Spring Banquet a successful event despite the new laws. We cannot afford to break the rules and pay the fines or loose our raffle license for violating the new rules.
