- Bring your Baptismal certificate to Lisa Simmons in the parish office as soon as you get it. You should write for these certificates as soon as possible so we can make sure you are eligible for Confirmation. It may take Parishes several weeks to send this certificate so you should write to them no later than December 1<sup>st</sup>.
- If you were not baptized Catholic, but in some other faith, and you entered into the Catholic Church by a **Profession of Faith**, you will need to write to the parish where you made that Profession of Faith and ask for certification of your Profession.
