Friday - 31st August: - 1st Walk Back: 0900 - 1245. 2nd Walk Back: 1300 - 1645.... max 10 rds per range. Shooters must supply their own paper zeroing targets or arrange for targets - Match Targets will NOT be available for zeroing.

Saturday - September 1st: 2 Man Tactical Team: 0900 - 1700 hrs

Ranges: 100m - 200m - 300m: 76 to 96 rds per competitor as we may move up Sunday matches

Sunday- September 2nd: 2 Man Tactical Team: 0900 - 1700 hrs

Ranges: 300m - 400m - 500m : 100 to 115 rds per competitor as we may move up Monday matches

Monday - September 3rd: 2 Man Tactical Team: 0900 - 1700 hrs

Ranges: 600m. 56 rds per competitor

- Note #1 Competitors shall be at the range at least 1 hour before match commencement and be ready to assist in range set up, squadding and completing entry forms. Competitors arriving late will be served when time permits at the discretion/mercy of stats office personnel.
- Note #2 Bring ammunition for all three days as we may move up matches from the succeeding day, time permitting.
- Note #3 A match committee, chaired by the Match Director, will include one Law Enforcement competitor, one Military competitor and one Civilian competitor. Match committee decision are binding and final.
