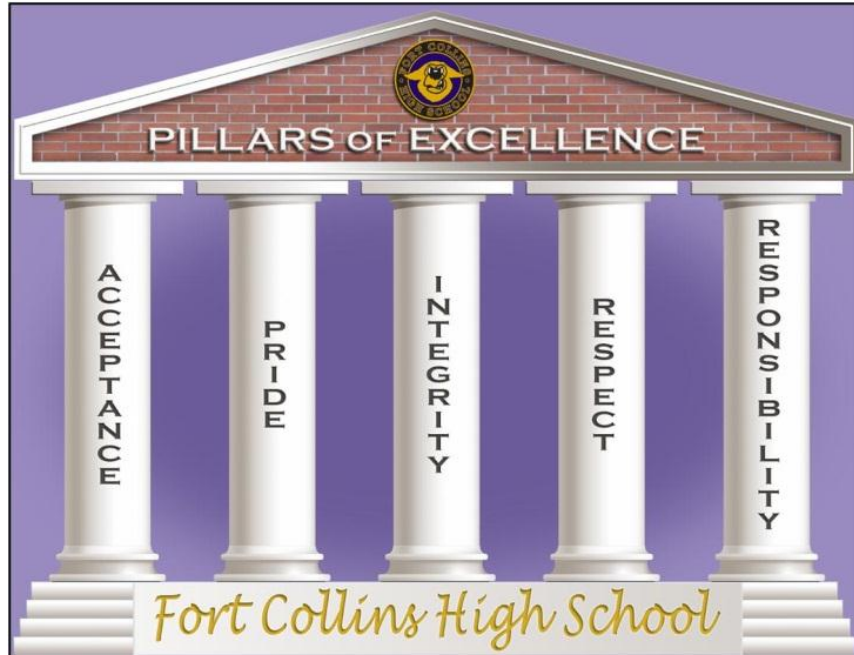

## TIPS ON APPLYING FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

When filling out a scholarship application, your goal should be to present yourself in the best way possible. Applying for a scholarship is much like applying for employment. You need to:

- 1) Be accurate
- 2) Be descriptive
- 3) Impress your audience
- 4) Be neat and organized in your written presentations. To do this, please use the following tips:

### 1. Read the Directions Carefully:

- Read the directions completely and carefully before you begin filling out the forms
- To ensure your eligibility, it is important that you carefully read the **criteria of each** scholarship for which you would like to apply
- Students will seriously jeopardize their chances of receiving an award by submitting their applications late or incomplete

### 2. Complete Application:

- The 2014 PSD Local Scholarship packet can be found on the Fort Collins High School website
  - Click on the Student Services tab, then scholarships
  - The link is at the top of the scholarship page
- The application is in pdf format (use Adobe Reader to fill out the application)
  - **Save the Local Scholarship Application to your computer, then upload it in with Adobe Reader**
- Please type directly on the form in Adobe Reader (you can save your work and come back to it anytime, the application does not need to be filled out in one sitting)
- When complete, print the application and drop it off in Student Services to Mrs. Lae in a single, complete packet, including required essays and letters of recommendation
- If you absolutely do not have access to the internet, you may pick up a hard copy of the application in Student Services.
  - If you are submitting a hard copy of the application, please **type or neatly print in black ink**
  - Do not use pencil or blue ink. Neatness of the application is taken into consideration

### 3. Required Essay:

- What are your post-secondary plans and career goals and why have you made these choices
  - Please include your name at the top of the essay
  - The essay should be no more than the equivalent of 2 pages, typed and double-spaced
- Some scholarships require their own essays, please read the criteria for those specific scholarships carefully (scholarships that require additional essays is listed below)
  - Failure to submit such essays may disqualify you from applying for that scholarship
  - Include your name and the name of the scholarship at the top of your essay

### 4. Give Yourself Ample Time To Do Your Best Work:

- Your best effort takes time
- The better you present yourself; the better your chances are of receiving a scholarship
- Use correct spelling, grammar, punctuation, and manner of expression
- Organize your information in a readable format
- Take every measure to make your application neat and organized, as copies of your application will be given to several scholarship committees in the process of selecting their scholarship recipients

## 5. Letters of Recommendation:

- When requesting letters of recommendation give the person writing the recommendation **at least 2 weeks** to complete your letter
- Make sure the person who is writing your letter of recommendation has a copy of your resumé (Academic Profile)
- Letter of Recommendation instructions and Academic Profiles can be found in the Student Services office and on the Student Services website:
  - Student Services
  - College & Career Planning
  - scroll down to College Application and look for Academic Profile
- If a staff member has already uploaded a letter to Naviance for you, we must have their permission to print it out for inclusion in this packet
- Please have them sign on the checklist (page 4, F) to release their confidential letter for your application. This is your responsibility; we will **NOT** track down letters of recommendation for you!

## 6. Check List:

- Use the application completion check list provided on page 4 of this packet in assembling your application
- Be sure you have included any required essays or forms in addition to the basic application
- Your packet will be copied and distributed to the committees of scholarships you have marked

## 7. Follow these Instructions:

- Print on one side only
- Do not 3-hole punch
- Do not staple
- Do not place in binder
- Do not use page protectors
- Do not attach resumé or photos
- You may paperclip your packet or place it in a pocket folder
- Drop your completed application off in Student Services to Mrs. Lae by January, 29, 2014, 3:30pm
  - This deadline is strict and no exceptions will be made

**Please be patient as the process of reviewing and awarding scholarships can be lengthy.**

**Notification of scholarship recipients will be completed by the first of May.**

It is best to get your application in early. **If the application turned in is incomplete (i.e. without the required essay, etc.), the application will not be considered.** A student must be eligible for each specific scholarship they check. Applications for students who do not meet all criteria of a particular scholarship will not be considered.

Place an "X" beside each scholarship for which you wish to apply and for which you are eligible.

Please be advised that these scholarships are offered at the sole discretion of our generous donors and the following information regarding these scholarships was provided by these donors.

### **Alonzo Martinez Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Awarded on academic standards
- Financial need
- Awarded only to a student of Spanish surname or Hispanic background
- Purpose is to encourage education beyond high school level
- Selection committee is composed of Alonzo Martinez American Legion Auxiliary members
- **Student statement of Hispanic origin is required-mother's surname is adequate**
- To be used at Colorado schools only

**Amount:** Varies each year depending on donations and number of applicants

### **Ben Dawson Memorial Scholarship\*\***

**Criteria:**

- Applicant must be a FCHS graduating senior
- Exhibiting leadership qualities and a well-rounded personality
- Selection is based on ambition and ideals of the student
- Scholarship is for college freshman year only

**Amount:** \$500 scholarship

### **Brian Ball Memorial Scholarship\*\***

**Criteria:**

- Must be a graduating FCHS senior
- Involved in school and/or community activities
- Planning to study in a **helping profession**
- Other scholarships may be restricting

**Amount:** \$500 scholarship

## **\_\_\_\_\_Compton Music Award\*\***

### **Criteria:**

- Award is to be made annually to a FCHS graduating senior who is a member of the A Cappella Choir
- The nominee must have been a member of the A Cappella Choir for two years, or in the opinion of the Selection Committee have a one year equivalency in another school
- The nominee must be an excellent vocalist, must be a superior citizen, must demonstrate the ability to do college level course work and select one of the following:
  1. To study music as a major or minor **or**
  2. Become a member of a college concert choir **or**
  3. Take private voice lessons in college
  4. Must be enrolled and attend a college/university with an accredited School of Music
  5. A prodigy might use this assistance at a specialized school of music

**Amount:** \$250 scholarship

## **\_\_\_\_\_Dan Preble Memorial Scholarship**

### **Criteria:**

- A senior at any Poudre School District high school
- Must have expressed interest and intent to enroll in a science area of study **and/or** participate in a college sport
- **Essay:** 300-500 word essay explaining what inspires you to choose a science area of study and/or participate in a college athletic program
- A letter of recommendation from a science teacher or coach that addresses your interest and potential for success is required

**Amount:** \$500 scholarship

## **\_\_\_\_\_Dean & Sherry Pedersen Memorial Scholarship**

### **Criteria:**

- Must enroll in Front Range Community College, Larimer County campus in the same year as high school
- Open to any certificate or degree program, but priority consideration will be given to those enrolled in an Education, Math, Science, Engineering studies or Medical field
- 2.0 GPA or higher
- Selection based on financial need and ability/ambition to succeed academically

**Amount:** \$1,500 over two semesters (Must maintain a 3.0 GPA at end of first semester)

## **\_\_\_\_\_“Doc” Pike “All Ways” a Lambkin Memorial Scholarship\*\***

### **Criteria:**

- Recipient will have achieved a balance of excellence in Athletics, Academics, and Activities
- 3.0 GPA or higher
- Must have demonstrated outstanding participation in either 2 sports and 1 co-curricular activity **or** 2 co-curricular activities and 1 sport
- Must demonstrate attributes admired, respected and demonstrated by Doc Pike: honesty, integrity, hard work, compassion, dedication, humor, respect for diversity, and school spirit
- Must have made a positive difference at Fort Collins High School through leadership, involvement, and influence
- Attendance at an **in-state college** is required of the recipient

**Amount:** \$1,000 non-renewable

## Don Unger Scholarship

### Criteria:

- Student must have participated in the **AVID Program**. (Advancement Via Individual Direction)

**Amount:** \$1,000 scholarship

## Elks Academic Scholarship

### Criteria:

- Based on scholarship, leadership, and financial need, although need is not a major selection criterion and should not deter application
- To be used at any accredited degree-granting University or College
- Renewable for a second year
- Alternates will be selected
- Selection committee consists of counselors and educators who are Elks members
- Top applicants will interview at the Elks Club

**Amount:** \$1,000 (\$500/semester) Renewable for one year, multiple scholarships offered

## Elks Vocational Scholarship

### Criteria:

- Based on scholarship, leadership, financial need and a well-defined plan for technical or other vocational employment
- For one year to further vocational training only at a two year community or junior college or a certified vocational school
- Alternates will be selected
- Selection committee consist of Elks members
- Top applicants will interview at the Elks Club

**Amount:** \$600 (\$300/semester), multiple scholarships offered

## Elmer C. "Luke" Luther Memorial Scholarship\*\*

### Criteria:

- Must be a FCHS graduating senior exhibiting leadership qualities and financial need
- Applicants must be planning to enter the business and/or mathematics fields
- The FCHS business faculty will choose the recipient

**Amount:** \$1,000 scholarship

## Fort Collins Children's Theatre Scholarship

### Criteria:

- Must have committed time & talents to your high school and the Fort Collins Community
- Preferred, but not required to have had personal involvement with *The Fort Collins Children's Theatre*
- To be used at any accredited college or university
- Must major in Communication Arts (including Music, Theatre, Screen Writing, Film & TV production, Directing, Recording or Technical Theatre)
- 3.0 GPA or higher
- Submit resumé of performance activities in and out of school or experience relative to current endeavors
- You may submit a video interview limited to 3 minutes; however, this is not required

- If you have been involved with the *Fort Collins Children's Theatre*, include a statement of 200 words or less expressing why you would recommend *The Fort Collins Children's Theatre* to others in your essay

**Amount:** \$750 scholarship

### **Front Range Center For Brain & Spine Surgery**

#### **Outstanding Senior Science Student Award**

**Criteria:**

- Awarded to a Poudre School District senior with strong science grades and planning on pursuing a career in a science field
- Top finalists will be scheduled to interview

**Amount:** \$1,000 scholarship

### **J. Fred Kapp Memorial Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Graduating senior from Fort Collins area schools
- Parents/guardians must be of Jewish faith with student self-identifying as Jewish
- Consistent service to community-at-large (mitzvot); acceptance to institution of higher learning--college, community college, or technical school (kavannah)
- 3.0 GPA or explanation of unusual circumstances
- Essay on post-secondary plans, career goals; **give examples of your involvement with the Jewish Community at-large**, should be no more than 2 pages, typed and double-spaced.
- Personal interview with scholarship committee from Congregation Har Shalom.

**Amount:** \$500 scholarship

### **Jim Lombardi Memorial Education Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Jim Lombardi was a well-known Physical Education teacher with Poudre School District for many years. He lived and died with a passion for fitness, wellness and recreation. After his death while on a mountain climbing expedition, the Jim Lombardi Memorial Scholarship was established for a PSD senior entering an accredited college or university and majoring in Physical Education, Health Education, or Recreation
- 3.2 GPA or higher

**Amount:** \$500 scholarship

### **Julia M. Luther Memorial Scholarship\*\***

**Criteria:**

- Must be a FCHS graduating senior exhibiting leadership qualities and financial need
- Must be planning to enter the education field, preferably in the English/Language Arts area
- The FCHS Language Arts faculty will choose the recipient

**Amount:** \$1,000 scholarship



### **\_\_\_\_\_Lena & Evelyn Traut Memorial Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Awarded to a Poudre School District senior
- 3.5 GPA or higher
- Must participate in high school activities; plan to enter field of education as a teacher, preferably elementary and attend an **in-state** college or university after high school graduation

**Amount:** Two \$500 scholarships

### **\_\_\_\_\_Lise Gausman Memorial Scholarship\*\***

**Criteria:**

- A senior(s) interested in pursuing a degree at any university or college
- Financial need may be considered as a factor for selection
- 3.25 GPA or higher
- A one to two page essay reflecting your views on **what it means to you that one should “truly LIVE each and every moment of your precious life”** is required

**Amount:** Amount Varies

### **\_\_\_\_\_Manuel Cordova Memorial Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- 3.2 GPA or higher
- Must be enrolled at a 2 or 4 year accredited Colorado School, based on financial need

**Amount:** Amount Varies

### **\_\_\_\_\_Martha Trimble Memorial Scholarship – Colorado State University**

**Criteria:**

- Must be a **female** senior in attendance at one of the 5 Fort Collins high schools
- Must live within the Fort Collins city limits; must have continuously attended school in the Poudre School District since she started public education
- Must be planning to attend CSU in a liberal arts field of study
- 3.5 GPA or higher
- Selection committee will be used to determine the recipient from pool of applicants submitted by each high school. The scholarship custodian will establish renewal of scholarship moneys beyond the first year of attendance at college.

**Amount:** \$3,000 with possible renewal beyond the first year

### **\_\_\_\_\_Martha Trimble Memorial Scholarship – University Of Colorado**

**Criteria:**

- Must be a **female** senior in attendance at one of the 5 Fort Collins high schools
- Must live within the Fort Collins city limits; must have continuously attended school in the Poudre School District since she started public education
- Must be planning to attend CU in a liberal arts field of study
- 3.5 GPA or higher
- Selection committee will be used to determine the recipient from pool of applicants submitted by each high school. The scholarship custodian will establish renewal of scholarship moneys beyond the first year of attendance at college.

**Amount:** \$2,000 with possible renewal beyond the first year

## **\_\_\_\_\_ Martha Trimble/McCormick Memorial Scholarship – Colorado State University**

### **Criteria:**

- Applicant may be **either male or female** and must be planning on attending CSU in the Fall of 2014
- Must have attended a Poudre School District school at least 10 of 13 years (K-12) of school
- Applicant must reside within 20 miles of Fort Collins
- Scholarship may be used for tuition and expenses

**Amount:** \$6,300 scholarship, renewable each year

## **\_\_\_\_\_ Megan Marie Nuttall McGrew Memorial Scholarship\*\***

### **Criteria:**

- Play a woodwind instrument and intend to participate in a college music program (need not major in music)
- financial need considered, but not a determining factor
- 3.0 GPA or higher
- Essay on what role music plays in your life is required. The essay should be no more than the equivalent of 2 pages, typed and double-spaced.

**Amount:** \$500 scholarship

## **\_\_\_\_\_ Mildred McAnelly Scholarship**

### **Criteria:**

- Student must be in need of assistance to attend college and must have maintained a high scholastic record in high school or have every indication of being able to assimilate a college education, or complete the high school education and become a credit to the community
- A desire for the student(s) to become a teacher is a consideration, but not a necessity

**Amount:** One \$625 scholarship per high school

## **\_\_\_\_\_ Otterbox Entrepreneur Scholarship (Ottercares)**

### **Criteria:**

- Applicant must be from **ANY** of the high schools located in Fort Collins
- Must be goal oriented, self-motivated, exemplify an entrepreneurial spirit, with plans to attend a University, College, Community College, or Vocational school **in Colorado**
- Please submit an essay or a video no longer than 3 minutes, which answers the question: **What does being an entrepreneur mean to you and how will you use entrepreneurialism to achieve your dream for the future?** The essay should be typed, double spaced, and a length of 1-2 pages
- The top applicants will be asked to participate in a brief interview

**Amount:** \$1,000 scholarship, multiple awarded

## **\_\_\_\_\_ PASE (Poudre Association of School Executives) Education Focus Scholarship**

### **Criteria:**

- Scholarship has 2 priority tiers. When the first is satisfied at a school, the 2<sup>nd</sup> level is not awarded
  - First priority – Scholarship awarded to **children of PASE members**
  - Second priority – Scholarship awarded to any prospective student who wants to work in **public education** and is pursuing college coursework to support that career pathway
  - **3.0 GPA** and be active in extra-curricular school and community activities
  - Financial need considered when everything else is equal

**Amount:** \$1,000 scholarship (maximum of 6 scholarships given out)

## Poudre Education Association Scholarship

### Criteria:

- Selection is made by the *PEA Scholarship Committee*
- Selection is based on scholarship (GPA), citizenship, service to the school and community, and need (including previously awarded scholarships)
- Essay explaining, “**How an educational experience has made an impact or difference in your life**”. The essay should be no more than the equivalent of 2 pages, typed and double-spaced. You do not have to plan on being a teacher to apply for this scholarship

**Amount:** Amount varies. One scholarship will be awarded to a senior from each PSD high school

## Poudre Retired School Employees’ Association Memorial Scholarship

### Criteria:

- Must enroll in Front Range Community College (Larimer County) in the same year as graduation, and enroll in one of the certificate or degree programs. Selection is by Poudre Retired School Employees’ Association Committee

**Amount:** \$1,200 for tuition and fees over two semesters. Must maintain a 2.5 GPA at end of first semester

## Rotary Club Scholarship

### Criteria:

- To be used at CSU or Front Range Community College (Fort Collins Campus only)
- Selection based on need, scholarship, community service, and leadership **all weighted equally**
- Must include your financial statement. Rotary Selection Committee will interview top applicants
- Additional information required for semi-finalists. (Each high school submits 10 - semi-finalists).

**Amount:** Up to \$2,000 scholarships to CSU or FRCC. (\$1,000/semester if 3.0 GPA is maintained.)

## Sandra Kobelt Hau Memorial Scholarship

Sandy Hau passed away on July 4, 2009 after a lengthy and courageous battle with cancer. She spent more than 25 years passionately volunteering in the Poudre School District, where all 5 of her children graduated from Fort Collins High School.

### Criteria:

- Applicant may be from any of the high schools located in Fort Collins
- He or she should exemplify leadership, be goal oriented, self-motivated, have **participated in a sport or the Arts**
- Plan to attend a University, College, Community College, or Vocational school in the Fall of 2014
- Essay describing how your life will influence and make an impact in the lives of those around you (750 words)

**Amount:** Two \$500.00 scholarships & one \$1,000 scholarship

## Shepardson Stem Educating All Children Scholarship

This scholarship recognizes Dr. Mary Kay Sommers’ passion for children and her life-long commitment to innovative education. Its purpose is to support a Poudre School District Graduate who has a passion for children and education in becoming a teacher.

### Criteria:

- 3.25 GPA or higher
- Volunteer time working with and for children
- Evidence of leadership skills
- Interested in becoming a teacher at any level

- Financial need may become a deciding factor
- All applicants who attended Shepardson will automatically make it to the committee review
- **Required: Must answer the following 5 questions (double space answers)**
  1. Why do you want to pursue a career in teaching?
  2. If you could change education in any way to make it more successful for all students (PK-12), what would you do?
  3. Describe someone or an event that highly influenced you in your interest to pursue teaching.
  4. Educators need to be advocates for providing the best education they can for all students. Describe something you feel strongly about that resulted in action on your part.
  5. What areas of education do you find highly compelling and why?

**Amount:** \$1,000 scholarship

### **Wayne Bromley Memorial Scholarship for Future Math Educators**

Wayne Bromley worked in Poudre School District for 24 years. He was a teacher and department chair at Boltz Junior High School and Fort Collins High School. He also served for 5 years as the District Mathematics Coordinator. He passed away after a long battle with cancer on December 23, 2009. Wayne was passionate about mathematics education. To honor that passion, this scholarship will support a senior in PSD who seeks a career as a mathematics teacher.

**Criteria:**

- Open to a senior at any Poudre School District high school who has expressed interest and intent to enroll in a mathematics teacher education program in Fall 2014
- A 300-500 word essay explaining **what inspires you to choose mathematics education as a career and why you believe you will be a successful mathematics teacher**
- One letter of recommendation from a current or former math teacher that addresses your interest in mathematics and potential for success

**Amount:** \$1,000 scholarship

### **The Will Schwartz Memorial Scholarship**

Will's life-long passion for music began when he started playing violin at the age of six. After serving in WWII and then receiving a Master's Degree from the Julliard School of Music in New York City (his home town), Will moved to Fort Collins to teach violin, orchestra and conducting at Colorado A&M. Shortly after his arrival in 1949, he founded a community orchestra, today a high-caliber professional group known as the Fort Collins Symphony.

Will's talent, vision and energy were inspirational to generations of musicians who played in his orchestra and studied with him at the Music department at Colorado State University. In addition to teaching, he spent many hours advising and counseling students in scholastic and personal life matters and always invited stranded students to join him and his family at holidays. *Many of his former students travelled from all over the country to attend a memorial concert in his honor.* He regularly performed as a violinist or conducted his orchestra for area K-12 students, for rest home residents and in agencies for developmentally disabled.

Music was Will's lifelong and constant companion. It greatly enriched his own life, and he in turn, through performing on the violin and with his own and many other orchestras throughout the world, enriched the life of countless others.

It is our hope that through the distribution of these awards, these students will continue Will's legacy—the love and sharing of music, for the betterment of themselves and those around them.

**Criteria:**

- **Required Essay:** What are your post-secondary plans and career goals? How does music fit in?
- **Audition required:** Applicants will be asked to perform a piece (or part of a piece) of their choosing, not to run longer than 7 minutes. Performances can be instrumental or choral.
- 3.2 minimum GPA – will not dictate award
- In-state college or university preferred, but will not impact award
- Financial need will be taken into consideration, but will not determine award

**Amount:** Amounts vary (one to three scholarships awarded)

Scholarships marked with a double asterisk (\*\*) are only offered to students from Fort Collins High School.
