Mad About Murals Leave your mark on Camp Menzies by using your artistic skills to create an amazing mural to be enjoyed by many generations of campers to come.
Arts Alive Experiment with the classic camp crafts of tie-dye and candle making in order to put a new, unique spin on the ones you made as a camper. (Includes tie-dye, batik, sculpture and drip candles.)
Eco-Explorers Set off on a hike around Camp Menzies' property while getting an up close look at the unique ecology of the Sierra Nevada.
Secret Garden Take a guided tour of Camp Menzies garden, pick up gardening tips, pickle summer vegetables and sew your own embroidered herb sachet filled with pickings from the garden.
Take Aim Get in touch with your inner Katniss by practicing your archery skills.
