NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Twentynine Palms, County of San Bernardino, California, will receive up to, but not later than the time set forth above, sealed contract bids for the award of a contract for the above project. All bids shall be made on the form furnished by the City and shall be opened and publicly read aloud at the above-stated time at the place of bid receipt identified above.

Bids must be placed in a sealed package with the project name and identification number typed or clearly printed on the lower left corner of the package.

PROJECT IDENTIFICATION NAME: Adobe Road Rehabilitation Phases 3 and 4 (Amboy Road to USMC Air Ground Combat Training Center)

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: Provide necessary labor, equipment and materials to install concrete curb and gutter, sidewalk, and asphalt concrete overlay along Adobe Road from Amboy Road to USMC Air Ground Combat Training Center, as specified on the drawings, and in these specifications and special provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

ENGINEER' ESTIMATE: \$4,370,000

COMPLETION OF WORK: All work shall be completed within 65 working days following written notice to proceed from the City.

OBTAINING BID DOCUMENTS: Contract documents for the above referenced project may be obtained at the Office of the City Engineer, City Hall, City of Twentynine Palms, upon payment of **\$65.00** for each set, **\$85.00** if mailed. This amount is not refundable.

Upon award of contract, a maximum of five (5) sets of plans and special provisions will be provided to the contractor, free of charge, for construction purposes.

BID BOND: Each bid response shall be accompanied by the bid securities and attachments as required in Section B – Instructions to Bidders. This may include, but not be limited to such items as: a list of proposed subcontractors, evidence of insurance, performance bonds and a labor and materials bonds as specified in the contract documents.

PREVAILING WAGE RATES: Bidders are advised that this project is funded with federal and other public funds. The federal requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act will apply to this project and those requirements will be enforced. The prime contractor and subcontractor are required to pay their laborers and mechanics employed under this contract a wage not less than the minimum wage for the work classifications specified in both the Federal and State wage decisions, when the prime contract amount exceeds \$2,000. The higher of the two wage classifications, State or Federal, Prevailing Wage will be enforced for all work under this contract. The prime contractor is responsible for ensuring subcontractor compliance with Davis-Bacon and Related Act requirements. The Federal Labor Standards Provisions (HUD 4010) apply. A copy of the Federal

Prevailing Wage (CA20030037 Modification #33) and HUD 4010 are attached.

CERTIFIED PAYROLL: A weekly certified payroll is required during the term of construction. Payment of contractor's invoice may be delayed when certified payrolls are not submitted weekly. The City shall make progress payments on any properly completed payment request submitted by the contractor. The payment request shall not be deemed properly completed unless certified payrolls WH-347, have been properly completed and submitted on a weekly basis for each week worked.

CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE: In accordance with the Provisions of California Public Contract Code Section 3300, the City of Twentynine Palms has determined that the Contractor shall possess a valid Class [A] General Engineering License at the time that the contract is awarded. Failure to possess the specified license shall render the bid as non-responsive and shall act as a bar to award of the contract to any bidder not possessing said license at the time of award.

SUBSTITUTE SECURITIES FOR RETENTION MONEYS: In accordance with Part 5 (Section 2230), Division 2 of the Public Contract Code, a contractor may substitute securities for retention moneys withheld by a public agency to ensure performance under this contract. At the request and expense of the contractor, securities equivalent to the amount withheld shall be deposited with the City of Twentynine Palms, or with a state or federally chartered bank, as the escrow agent, who shall then pay such moneys to the contractor, and upon satisfactory completion of the contract, the securities shall be returned to the Contractor.

REJECTION OF BIDS: The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids or any parts thereof and waive any irregularities or informalities in any bid or in the bidding and to make awards in all or part in the best interest of the City.

WITHDRAWAL OF BID: No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date set for the opening bids.
