- Called and committed, demonstrating a willingness to consistently enter into a kid's world to earn the right to be heard.
- Flexible with a positive attitude toward serving, learning and training.
- ❖ Able and willing to commit an average of 8-12 hours per week.

# **Responsibilities and Expectations**

Young Life leaders commit to:

- Contact Work: Invest a minimum of 1-3 times per week (3-5 hours) outside of Young Life activities, creatively spending time with kids.
- Regular involvement in club, Campaigners, and team meetings.
- Attendance at all area and regional leadership training and events.
- Building community through regular fellowship with area and team leaders.
- Availability for weekend and summer camps.
