Your most recent pay stub from the current employer, if applicable. If you will not be working or seeking a job for the remainder of 2011, we will need a signed statement from you to confirm your plans. If married send spouse's latest pay stub showing earnings year-to-date.

Your unemployment benefits, showing monthly amount, the starting and ending dates, and the maximum amount of benefits allowed for the filing period.

Your tax returns for the previous year, including W-2 forms and schedules.

If you are married, and your spouse has lost his/her job, please provide all of the information listed above for your spouse also.
