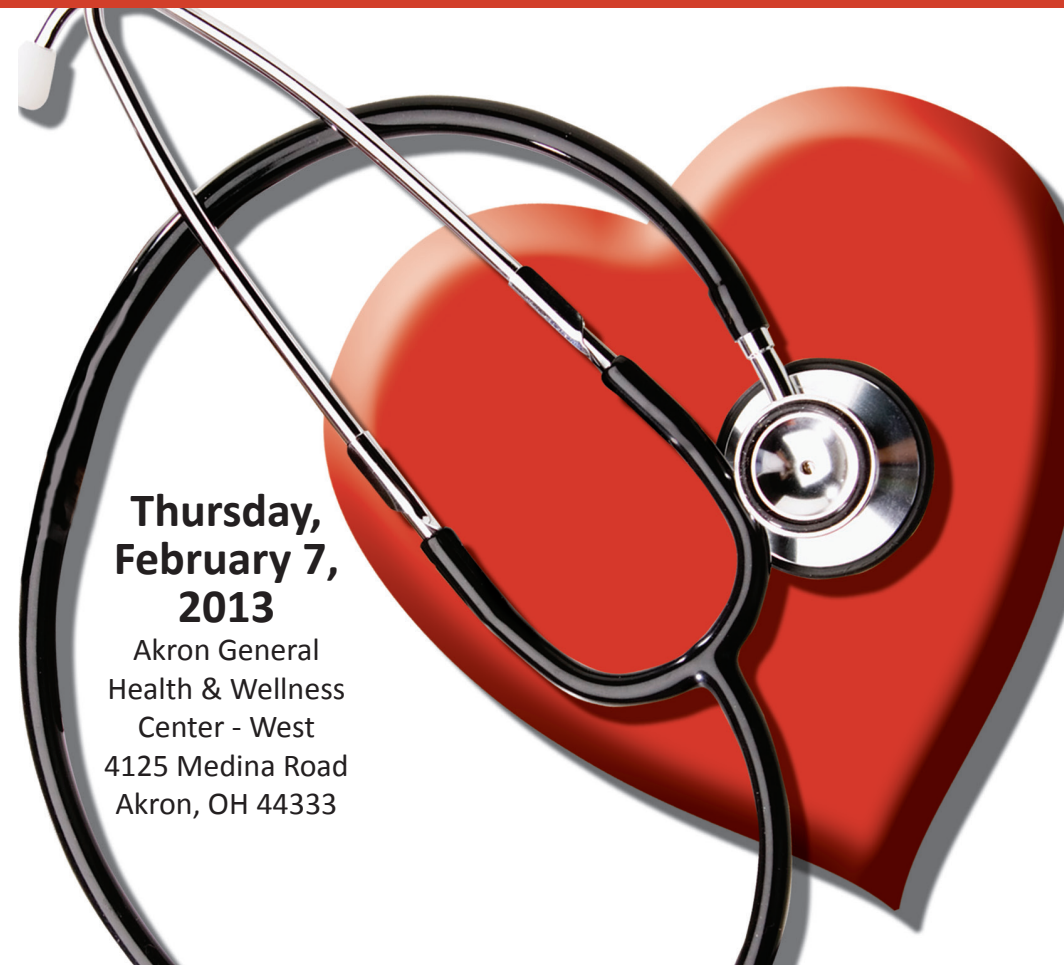

This course is a tribute to our friend and colleague, Denise L. Carrabine, RN. Denise was a member of the Coronary Care staff at Akron General Medical Center from 1983 until 1992. Her dedication to learning and love of cardiology inspired the establishment of this annual conference in her memory. COURSE CONTENT

Upon completion of this educational activity, the participant should be able to:

1. Recognize and discuss treatment options for acute DVT and identify treatment regarding indications and counter-indications.
2. Acknowledge risks, patient symptoms of possible heart and vascular disease within high-risk pregnancy.
3. List and compare criteria for determining myocardial infarction based on cardiac enzyme defined levels.
4. Discuss Nursing Law updates relevant to their practice licensing.
5. Cite most current, up-to-date treatments for thoracic aortic disease.
6. Utilize evidence-based care practices for treating patients with neurovascular disease.
7. State the rationale for a life vest and long term cardiac rhythm monitoring.
8. Offer suggestions and direction to indigent/uninsured patients to assistance programs/ resources regarding hospital and outpatient medical expenses, medications and those with ongoing chronic conditions.
9. Reflect and respond to patient care challenges incorporating life experiences, providing the opportunity for personal and professional growth in patient care skills

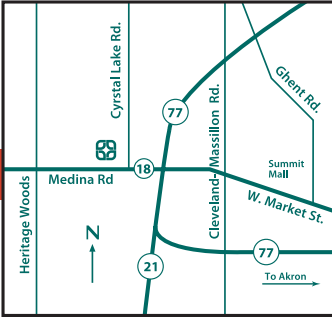
