Staff

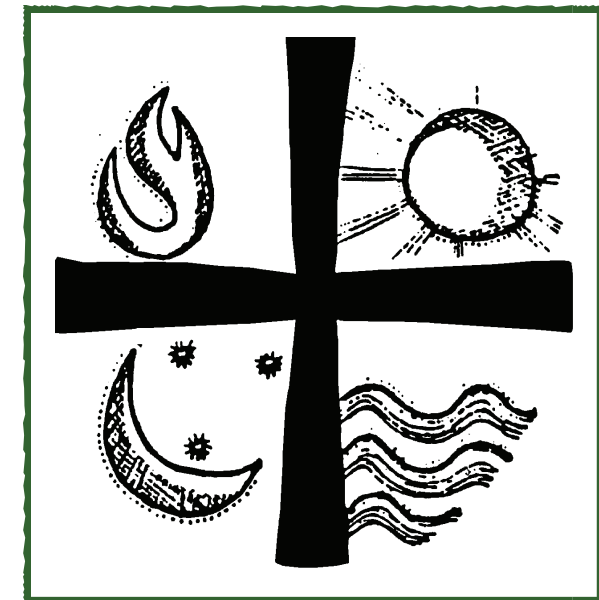

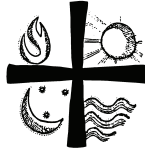

Camp starts Sunday at 7 p.m. (no meal is served). Check-in is from 5-7 p.m. and families are invited to bring dinner and enjoy it together on the grounds or in the dining hall. Camp ends Friday at 4 p.m.

A list of things to bring, map to camp, health/permission forms and other information will be mailed four weeks prior to camp.

Space is limited in each session, and they usually fill up fast, so register today to ensure you don't miss out on a great Summer Camp 2010!

Campers are assigned cabins **according to grade level!** We try to honor cabinmate requests, which can be indicated on the registration form. Bunk beds are provided, but blanket/sheets or sleeping bag and pillow are necessary.
