- Use a pen to circle or highlight days worked in the United States, whether for a US or non-US
- If more than 75% of your <u>work</u> days were in the US, you don't have to complete this page. The 75% test is computed using your "working period". A working period is the time frame where you are regularly required to be in the US. It does not have to be a whole year, and you may have more than one working period in a year. Normally, this test is meant for people who commute to work in the US. If you're not sure whether you meet this test, please complete the calendar.
