Individual Academic All-State: (Certificates are included in the school boxes)

First Team Criteria: (school issued)

1-3.60 or higher cumulative GPA

2-minimum junior in school

3-must be a letter winner or equivalent in activity nominated

4-must be a participant in a CHSAA sanctioned activity during current season

(Note: <u>Cumulative GPA's</u> through the Fall Semester will be used for Winter & Spring. <u>Cumulative GPA's</u> through the Spring Semester will be used for Fall.) (Note: A student <u>may be named</u> in each activity season.)

Honorable Mention: (school issued)

1-3.30 to 3.59 cumulative GPA

2-minimum junior academic standing

3-must be a letter winner or equivalent in activity nominated

4-must be a participant in a CHSAA-sponsored activity during current season

(Note: <u>Cumulative GPA's</u> through the Fall Semester will be used for Winter & Spring. <u>Cumulative GPA's</u> through the Spring Semester will be used for Fall.) (Note: A student may be named in each activity season.)

• **IBM Heroes**: IBM/850 KOA/Denver Broncos have teamed with CHSAA to recognize activity/athletic participants, coaches, administrators, officials and volunteers that promote the educational value of interscholastic participation. Nominations must be submitted via school personnel. Four to six winners are selected each week during the Denver Bronco season. Winners are recognized on various IBM promotional spots on 850 KOA. All winners will be invited to a reception at INVESCO hosted by IBM and 850 KOA as a "Thank you" for their contribution. (Form located at www.chsaa.org.) **Deadline: Forms should be turned in weekly throughout the Denver Bronco season.**

Submit your team's information in order to be eligible for the Les Schwab Academic Team Championship Award. All student-athletes listed will receive a certificate. The team with the $\underline{\textbf{highest}}$ GPA will receive a certificate and pin.

Criteria

- 1. Varsity team must have a 3.50 cumulative or higher GPA. Freshman use current GPA to date.
- 2. All varsity team members that participate for more than 75% of season/contest they must be figured in team GPA.
- 3. Varsity boys and girls teams must be figured separately.
- 4. Only varsity team members GPA's can be used no managers, team attendants, lower levels or trainers.

- 20 & 30 Year Service Award: This program is earmarked for any member of your staff who cumulatively has 20 or 30 years of service related to the areas of athletics and/or activities. Deadline: March 1, 2015
- **3-Sport Participation Award:** The CHSAA 3-Sport Participation Award recognizes outstanding student-athletes who have participated, at any level, in at least three different sports during one academic school year. Any student-athlete who has achieved this feat is eligible to receive this award. In March the Athletic Director will receive certificates in the mail. We encourage you to complete these certificates and then present them to your student-athletes during an all-school assembly. Please e-mail Jane Boudreau (jboudreau@chsaa.org) for additional certificates. During the Spring Season, we ask that you complete our interactive form (form #44) located on www.chsaa.org so that we can keep record of how many athletes are receiving this award. **Deadline: Interactive Form by March 30, 2015.**
- **CHSAA Active Scholar**: The CHSAA and the Colorado Rockies partner to "Rock the Rock Pile" in June. Each school nominates one-boy and one-girl to represent an Active scholar. School representatives are given a certificate and the program pays for their ticket to attend the designated Rockies game. From all the application forms one-boy and one-girl is selected to represent the scholars with an On-Field 'Rockies' ceremony and presentation of their \$1,000.00 scholarship. Schools use their discretion when submitting their nominees. Forms are sent to school in April. **Deadline: May 1, 2015.**
