You have been identified as a teaching assistant who may be eligible for the 2013-2014 <u>Teachers of</u> <u>Tomorrow Summer in the City Internship Program</u>. This grant is effective from July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014. Please read the following instructions carefully.

To be eligible you must:

- have successfully completed <u>60 or more</u> college credits.
- be in good academic standing as determined by the Institute of Higher Education (IHE) and have attended an accredited New York State institution in the current year.
- be enrolled *full-time* in a New York State registered teacher preparation program.
- demonstrate the desire to enter the teaching profession.
- be *recommended* by college or university to participate in this program.

In addition

• you must have been employed in one of the District's Summer School Programs during the Summer of 2013 *and worked for the duration of the program*.

If you meet the above eligibility criteria, you may apply to receive a stipend. The amount of the stipend will be based on the program in which you worked. A maximum stipend of \$1,000 will be paid for a 3.5 hours per day program; a maximum stipend of \$2,000 will be paid for a 6.5 hours per day program. Because this is a state grant, there are a limited amount of funds available; therefore, applications for this grant will be awarded and paid on a first come, first-served basis.

In order to apply for a stipend, you must complete and submit the following documentation:

- A completed application form, including all required signatures.
- Transcript(s) verifying successful completion of sixty (60) or more college credits.
