If you decide that you are happy for us to discuss the details of your claim with your landlord you can give us permission by signing the box below. If you give us permission, we would be able to tell your landlord whether:

- you have claimed Housing Benefit, or
- we have made a decision on your claim, or
- we need more information to make a decision on your claim, and what that information might be

We will also be able to tell your landlord about:

- any personal or household circumstances that affect your claim
- any financial circumstances that affect your claim

We will not give your landlord any information about:

• your forwarding address if you leave their property, unless you give us permission to do so.

You can withdraw your permission at any time. It will not affect your claim if you do not give us permission to discuss your claim with your landlord. If you want to give us permission to discuss your claim with your landlord please sign below.

You must tell us about these changes in writing – a telephone call is not enough. Don't rely on other people, other Council services such as our Housing Department or other agencies such as the Department for Work and Pensions to tell us.
