



SIPC Membership Agreement

The SIPC was organized to enable school districts of Illinois to leverage their purchasing power with the Illinois Public Higher Education Cooperative (IPHEC) for purchases of custodial goods and services to advance good health and promote environmental stewardship.

The Cooperative shall operate in accordance with Illinois statutes governing public school districts with respect to the receipt and expenditure of public funds, including but not limited to the State Finance Act (30 ILCS 105/1 et seq.), the Illinois Administrative Code (CH. XIII), the Illinois Purchasing Act (30 ILCS 505/1 et seq.), and the State Comptroller Act (15 ILCS 405/1 et seq.).

SIPC members agree to purchase their custodial supplies through SIPC contracted supplier(s). Cooperative members have access and permission to use all SIPC Management Solutions & Training materials. Any member may withdraw from the Cooperative at any time. Such member shall return all SIPC Management Solutions & Training materials.
