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Detroit-Metro Regional Consortium Motorcycle Safety Schedule 2014

Oakland Community College will again sponsor a Motorcycle Safety Program in conjunction with the Secretary of State.

Classes for the novice and experienced rider are offered in conjunction with the Secretary of State from March through September. Participants must be at least 15 years of age, and motorcycles are provided for student instruction for basic classes only. Course length varies, depending on the skill level. Upon successful completion of one of these courses, you will be given a completion card that the Secretary of State recognizes to waive the riding skills test required for a cycle endorsement. Note: If you fail the State skills test twice, or if you are under 18 years of age and fail our Returning Rider Basic Rider Course, the Secretary of State office requires you to take the Basic Rider Course.

Course Fee for all motorcycle classes is \$25.

YOU MUST PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE CLOTHING/GEAR, REQUIRED FOR ALL MOTORCYCLE CLASSES:

- Long sleeve jacket or heavy shirt: Arms must be covered while riding. It is best to dress in layers according to the weather; the outermost layer must have long sleeves.
- Long pants: Long pants only no shorts! We suggest jeans; man-made materials can melt when exposed to heat from engines or exhaust pipes.
- Helmet: Wear a DOT-approved helmet.
- Eye protection: Goggles or glasses (no face shields – they make it harder to hear instructions).
- Gloves: Any gloves will do, as long as they fit your hand and are full-fingered.
- Boots or heavy shoes: Your ankles must be covered. A shoe or boot with a six-inch top is fine. No high heels or high-top tennis shoes are permitted.
- Optional: rain gear; sunscreen

Mail the Motorcycle Safety Program registration form along with your payment. A CONFIRMATION WILL NOT BE MAILED TO YOU. REPORT TO YOUR CLASS AT THE SCHEDULED TIME. REFUND POLICY

THE \$25 COURSE FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE.

If after starting a class, we have to cancel it due to inclement weather, the class will be made up the following Tuesday and Thursday weather permitting.

Instructors/Equipment – All instructors are certified by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation and are approved by the Michigan Department of Education.

Motorcycles are furnished for all classes except the Returning Rider Basic Rider Course. Riders are required to furnish their own helmets, gloves, over-the-ankle boots, heavy-duty pants, jacket and rain or cold weather gear. THIS EQUIPMENT IS REQUIRED FOR ALL RANGE ACTIVITIES.

Within each of the following sections (time frames) you will receive approximately 20 hours of instruction; eight hours in the class including written tests and 12 hours on the range excluding the Returning Rider courses. Each section number represents one class, i.e., the class meets on all days listed with each section number.

BASIC RIDER COURSE

If you have minimal experience operating a motorcycle, this course is for you. Develop your basic riding skills as you learn proper turning, shifting and braking. You have approximately 16 hours of instruction – 5 in the classroom and 11 on the range. Motorcycles are provided for student use. Participants must be at least 15 years of age. For students under 18 years of age, a parent must sign a waiver that will be given to the student the first day of class. The waiver must be returned to the instructor before the student will be allowed to ride a motorcycle on the range. The first night is in the classroom (not on the range), so no protective gear is needed the first class meeting. You must bring protective gear, listed previously, for all range activities.

ONE WEEKEND

Course Fee: \$25 (NON-REFUNDABLE)

You should have riding experience, because the quick pace makes this the most physically and mentally challenging option. Class meets Friday, 6 pm to 10 pm; Saturday and Sunday, 8 am to 8 pm. You need to be available during the 12-hour period, but are not expected to be on site the entire time. Variable schedules will be assigned the first night of class.

RETURNING RIDER BASIC RIDER COURSE (RRBRC)

Course Fee: \$25 (NON-REFUNDABLE)

Do you know how to ride a motorcycle, but don't have a license? Or perhaps you have the license, but want to brush up on your riding skills? Review and practice the basic riding skills of braking, counter-steering, turning and speed judgment as you tune up your safe riding practices. You will take a riding skills test covering the riding exercises used in the Secretary of State Motorcycle Skills Test. Upon successful completion of this test and course, you will be given a completion card that the Secretary of State recognizes to waive the riding skills test required for a cycle endorsement. If you are under 18 years of age and fail this riding skills test, you must enroll in the 20-hour Extended Practice Basic Rider Course and pay the \$25 fee.

Each student must provide their own motorcycle. Scooters will be allowed in this class. Sharing is not allowed. The cycle must be titled, properly registered, and display a valid license plate. Each student must provide proof of insurance and the bike must pass a safety inspection.

Class meets 8 am to 6 pm.
