R isk assessment provides a logical, defensible method for allocating scarce funds for dam safety improvement. This seminar and workshop are based on the book *Risk and Uncertainty in Dam Safety*, the result of seven years of research sponsored by the Dam Safety Interest Group of CEA Technologies.

The seminar will be a lecture-style introduction to risk assessment for dams that will emphasize concepts, approaches, and pros and cons of risk-based dam safety assessment. It is suitable for dam owners, managers and supervisors, consultants or anyone with a general interest in dam risk assessment.

The workshop will be a hands-on work session with teams performing various aspects of a risk analysis.

Seminar attendance is limited to 100 registrants. Workshop attendance is limited to 45. The seminar is a prerequisite for the workshop.



Presenters

The main presenters will be the lead authors of the book *Risk and Uncertainty in Dam Safety,* Dr. Desmond Hartford, B.C. Hydro and Dr. Gregory Baecher, University of Maryland. They will be joined by contributors Karl Dise, U.S. Bureau of Reclamation; Marc Smith, Hydro Québec and Dr. Andy Zielinski, Ontario Power Generation.
