- 1. Enter Firefighter's Name
- 2. <u>Wildland Fire Training</u>: Enter DATE, COURSE TITLE, and HOURS for each firefighter. Courses approved are:
  - I-100 Incident Command System (3 hours)
  - I-200 Incident Command System (14 hours)
  - S-190 Introduction to Wildland Fire Behavior (6 hours)
  - S-130 Wildland Firefighter Training (30 hours)
  - S-131 Advanced Wildland Firefighter Training (8 hours)
  - S-211 Portable Pumps and Water Use (18 hours)
  - S-212 Wildfire Power Saws (30 hours)
  - S-215 Fire Operations in the Wildland Urban Interface (28 hours)
  - Course 1181- Wildland Firefighting for the Structural Firefighter (16 hours)
  - Course 1182- WUI Operations for Structural Firefighters (8 hours)



- 3. <u>Wildland Fire Equipment Construction</u>: Enter DATE, EQUIPMENT TYPE, and HOURS worked for each firefighter. Construction of pumper unit for Brush Truck, repair, and modifications needed to convert a truck to a Brush Truck, installation of slip-in (skid) unit and connections to make it operational.
- 4. <u>Dry Hydrant Installation/Maintenance</u>: Enter DATE and HOURS for each firefighter spent on dry hydrant installation and/or dry hydrant maintenance.
- 5. <u>Fire Department Official Approval</u>: The Chief, or a designated Time Officer for the fire department, must sign off for each firefighter's time. The fire department can go back to <u>April 1, 2015</u> and document time for Wildland Fire Training, Wildland Fire Equipment Construction, and/or Dry Hydrant Installation/Maintenance. Keep this Time Sheet on file at the fire department until it is asked for by the Forestry Commission. If a fire department receives a grant, a copy of the Time Sheet will have to be submitted to the Forestry Commission along with a Claim for Reimbursement for a Volunteer Fire Assistance NFP Grant.
