

IT IS TIME TO RENEW YOUR PAWNBROKER LICENSE

Your license to practice as a pawnbroker in the State of Alaska lapses after **December 31, 2013**. It is illegal for you to practice if your license has lapsed. There is no grace period. To renew your license for the period from January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2015, return this *signed and dated* application to the above address with a check or money order payable to the State of Alaska, or use the attached credit card payment form. Faxed or emailed applications will not be accepted. This is the only renewal notice you will receive. Incomplete applications or insufficient fees will result in your renewal being rejected.

PROCESSING TIME - The processing time for a correct and completed renewal application can be three to four weeks after receipt. Plan accordingly to ensure processing by the lapse date of January 1, 2014.

MAILED RENEWAL FORMS - If you received this renewal application in the mail with a barcode in the upper right hand corner of the first page, **do not duplicate this form for another professional's use.** The barcode is specific to your name and license number. Forms without the barcode are available on our website at *http://commerce.alaska.gov/occ.*

GENERAL INFORMATION

EXPIRED LICENSES: There is no "inactive" license status. Licenses which have expired more than five years cannot be renewed.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF RENEWED LICENSE: The effective date of a renewed license will be the date a complete renewal application is filed with the division as determined by 12 AAC 02.920 and 12 AAC 02.940.

SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS: In accordance with AS 08.01.100, the department is not authorized to renew a license unless the applicant's social security number has been provided to the department. If you do not have a social security number, you may download the Request for Exception from Social Security Number Requirement form at *http://commerce.alaska.gov/occ* or contact the division. If you previously qualified for a waiver to this requirement, you must still requalify to renew.

PAYMENT OF CHILD SUPPORT AND STUDENT LOANS - If the Alaska Child Support Enforcement Division has determined that you are in arrears on child support, or if the Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education has determined you are in loan default, you may be issued a nonrenewable temporary license valid for 150 days. Contact Child Support Services at (907) 269-6900 or the Postsecondary Education office at (907) 465-2962 or 1-800-441-2962 to resolve payment issues.

PUBLIC INFORMATION - Please be aware that all information on this renewal form will be available to the public, unless required to be kept confidential by state or federal law. Information about current licensees, including mailing addresses, is available on the division's website at *www.commerce.alaska.gov/occ* under License Search.

BUSINESS LICENSES - Renewal applications for business licenses are mailed separately. For more information about business licenses, call (907) 465-2550 or access *www.commerce.alaska.gov/occ.*

ABANDONMENT - An application is considered abandoned when 12 months have elapsed since correspondence was last received from or on behalf of the applicant (12 AAC 02.910). An abandoned application is denied without prejudice.
